- ≈ Jaguar Land Rover (JLR - subsidiary of Tata Motors) invests £ 240 million to build new plant in Rio De Janeiro, Brazil JLR says -Hope to start output from Brazil plant from 2016 -Brazil manufacturing unit to have capacity of 24,000 units per year.
- ≈ Hinduja Global -Order pipeline currently at USD 125 million -US units to service 33 percent of orders, Philippines 36 percent - India business affected by telecom sector issues -India facilities to service 9 percent of order pipeline.

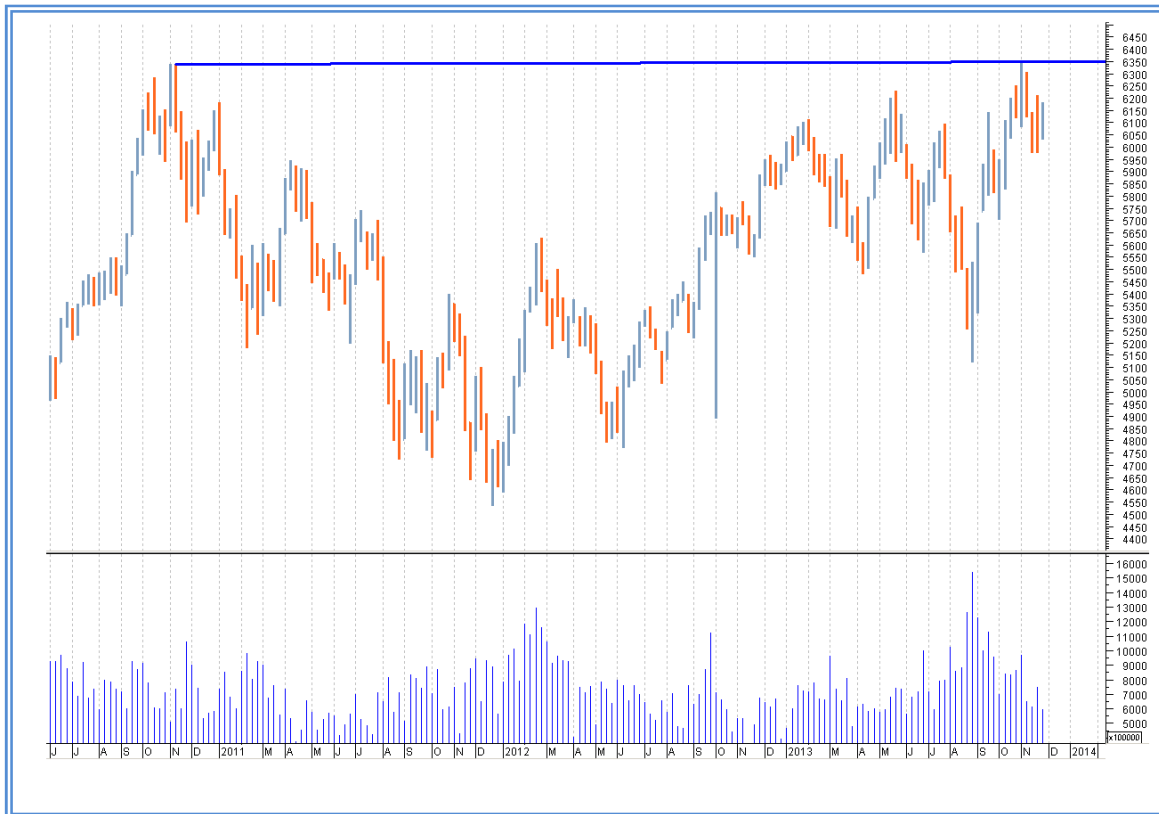
