MARKET COMMENTARY

Indian markets closed with moderate losses in Wednesday's trade. Markets continued to reel under pressure as investors reduced their exposure in local equities ahead of the release of Federal Reserve's policy statement due later in the day that is expected to give direction on interest rates there. Both Sensex and Nifty were closed below crucial 28,650 and 8,700 levels respectively, with losses of around half a percent. For today's trade Nifty likely to trade in the range between 8710 – 8740 in the upper side and 8660 -8640 in the lower side.

 - ➤ U.S. Stocks Decline for Second Session amid Fed Rate Speculation: - U.S. stocks fell for a second day as investors speculated the Federal Reserve will signal a change in its stance on the timing for higher interest rates.
 - WTI oil hits fresh 6-year low after bearish U.S. supply data: West Texas Intermediate oil futures fell to the lowest level since March 2009 on Wednesday, after data showed that oil supplies in the U.S. rose to the highest level on record, exacerbating fears over a glut in supplies. The U.S. Energy Information Administration said in its weekly report that U.S. crude oil inventories rose by 9.6 million barrels in the week ended March 13, compared to expectations for an increase of 3.8 million barrels.
 - Gold holds steady near 4-month low ahead of Fed, Yellen: - Gold held steady near the lowest level in more than four months on Wednesday, ahead of the Federal Reserve's highly-anticipated policy statement due later in the day.
 - Copper tumbles to 3-week low after China home price data: - Copper futures tumbled to a three-week low on Wednesday, as mounting concerns over the health of China's property sector dampened appetite for the red metal.
 - Natural gas futures edge lower after Tuesday's 5% rally: - U.S. natural gas prices gave back some of the previous session's 5% gain on Wednesday, as market participants looked ahead to fresh weekly information on U.S. gas inventories.
