

Indian equity markets closed on a flattish note in Friday's trade. The sentiments were on pessimistic note despite reports from Fitch, as the global rating agency just about retained India's credit outlook at 'stable' saying although dynamism is back in the economy translation of reforms into higher growth would depend upon actual implementation. Investors have started eyeing corporate earnings which is likely to be the next immediate trigger for the markets as companies are expected to report Jan-March earnings starting next week. Traders were seen piling positions in Realty, Infra and PSU stocks while selling was witnessed in Capital Goods, Bankex and IT sector stocks. For today's trade nifty likely to trade in the range between 8820 - 8830 in the upper side and 8760 – 8750 in the lower side.

 - ➤ U.S. Stocks Advance before Earnings Reports as GE Shares Rally: - U.S. stocks rose, with the Standard & Poor's 500 Index heading for a weekly gain, after General Electric Co. announced a broad restructuring plan and investors awaited further clues on the strength of corporate profits.
 - China Money Rate in Longest Slide Since 2009 as Funding Cost Cut: -China's benchmark money-market rate dropped for a sixth week, the longest run of declines since 2009, as the central bank guided funding costs lower.
 - Shanghai Composite Index Climbs above 4,000 after Inflation Data: -China's stocks rallied, with the Shanghai Composite Index closing above the 4,000 level for the first time since 2008, after data showed deflationary pressures easing.
 - ➤ It's ECB Versus Investors as Bond Scarcity Pushes Yields Lower: -Germany's government bonds extended an advance that pushed yields to record lows as investors rushed to compete with demand from the European Central Bank's debt-purchase program.
 - Russia Moves to Check Demand for Ruble with Higher FX Repo Rates: -The Bank of Russia said it will increase the cost of borrowing foreign currency through its operations for the second time in as many weeks, stepping up measures to blunt the world's best rally by the ruble.
