

MARKET COMMENTARY

Indian equity markets closed with significant gains in Friday's trade. The sentiments were on optimistic note after reports suggested that government has set-up a panel for suggesting ways to resolve MAT dispute as well as some other tax issues. The sentiments also got support after Harvard study reported that India is projected to achieve highest annual GDP growth rate of 7.9% over next 8 years, overtaking its South Asian economic rival China. Traders were seen piling position in Realty, Auto and Bankex stocks while selling was witnessed in Consumer Durables sector stocks. For today's trade Nifty likely to trade in the range between 8230 – 8250 in the upper side and 8150 – 8110 in the lower side.

 - U.S. Stocks Rise as Jobs Data Spur Optimism on Economy, Rates: - U.S. stocks rose after a rebound in hiring last month bolstered optimism that economic growth is accelerating, but not fast enough to warrant higher interest rates in June. Payrolls rebounded in April following an even bigger setback a month earlier than previously estimated, a sign companies are confident the U.S. economy will reboot after stagnating early this year. The unemployment rate dropped to 5.4 percent
 - ➤ U.S. Unemployment Falls to Lowest Level since May 2008:- April's jobcreation score was better, March was worse, and the U.S. jobless rate crept closer to the Federal Reserve's moving target for full employment.
 - oil futures rise as markets await U.S. nonfarm payrolls: Crude oil futures rose on Friday, as the commodity rebounded from losses posted in the previous session amid broad profit taking and as investors awaited the release of upcoming U.S. nonfarm payrolls data. Oil prices came under pressure on Thursday as a broadly stronger U.S. dollar prompted market players to lock in gains from a recent rally which took prices to the highest level of the year.
 - Gold futures edge higher, eyes on U.S. jobs data: Gold prices edged higher in European morning hours on Friday, but gains were limited as demand for the greenback remained supported by Thursday's jobless claims data and as markets eyed an upcoming report on U.S. nonfarm payrolls.
