

MARKET COMMENTARY

Indian equity markets closed with moderate gain in Wednesday's trade. The sentiments were on optimistic note from the early trade after UN World Economic Situation and Prospects (WESP) reported that India's economy is projected to grow by 7.6% this year and 7.7% in 2016, overtaking China which is projected to grow by 7% in 2015 and 6.8% next year. Traders were seen piling position in IT, TECK and Bankex stocks while selling was witnessed in Auto, Metal and Capital Goods sectors stocks. For today's trade Nifty likely to trade in the range between 8445 – 8460 in the upper side and 8410 – 8390 in the lower side.

 - ➤ U.S. Stocks Fluctuate near Records before Fed Meeting Minutes: U.S. stocks fluctuated, with equities near all-time highs, amid a selloff in airline shares and as investors await minutes from the Federal Reserve's April meeting. U.S. stocks held near their records yesterday as improving housing-starts data bolstered speculation the economy will rebound from a weak winter. The data supported the Fed's view that a slowdown in first-quarter growth was temporary, as policy makers debate the timing of raising interest rates.
 - Copper futures slump to fresh 3-week low on stronger dollar: - Copper prices fell to the lowest level in nearly three weeks on Wednesday, as a broadly stronger U.S. dollar dampened the appeal of the red metal.
 - Natural gas futures rebound with all eyes on weekly storage data: - U.S. natural gas prices rebounded from the previous session's heavy losses on Wednesday, as market participants looked ahead to fresh weekly information on U.S. gas inventories to gauge the strength of demand for the fuel.
 - Gold futures turn higher as investors look ahead to Fed minutes: - Gold prices erased earlier losses to trade modestly higher on Wednesday, as investors looked to the minutes of the Federal Reserve's April meeting, due for release later in the session, for fresh indications on the timing of an initial rate hike.
 - ➤ WTI oil futures off highs after U.S. supply data: - West Texas Intermediate oil futures backed off session highs Wednesday, despite data showing that oil supplies in the U.S. fell for the third consecutive week last week.
