

  - Euro Weakens on Greece as Emerging Stocks, Spanish Bonds Decline: - The euro weakened after Greece told creditors to lower demands that are holding up bailout funds. Emerging-market stocks fell as speculation grew the U.S. was moving closer to raising interest rates, while Polish equities slid the most in four months and Spanish markets dropped.
  - Natural gas futures fall to 2-week low on bearish weather outlook: - U.S. natural gas prices traded at the lowest level in nearly two weeks on Monday, as forecasts for mild weather across the U.S. in the week ahead dampened near-term demand expectations for the fuel. Weather forecasting models called for slightly warmer than average temperatures across the U.S. over the next ten days, although not yet enough to significantly boost cooling demand.
  - Copper trades near 3-week low as stronger dollar weighs: - Copper prices held near the previous session's threeweek low on Monday, as a broadly stronger U.S. dollar dampened the appeal of the industrial metal. The greenback strengthened after Federal Reserve Chair Janet Yellen said on Friday that interest rates will be raised later in the year. After that, future rate hikes will be small and gradual over the next several years, Yellen added.

A stronger dollar reduces demand for raw materials as an alternative investment and makes dollar-priced commodities more expensive for holders of other currencies.
