

 - U.S. Equities Advance as Intel Rebounds, Energy Rises With Oil: U.S. stocks rose from near a two-month low, as Intel Corp. led technology shares higher while energy companies gained with oil and banks climbed for a second day. The S&P 500 has traded in its tightest weekly range since the mid-'90s, signaling investor uncertainty as to whether the economic recovery is strong enough to withstand a rate increase. Reports on retail sales and jobless claims later this week may offer further clues.
 - ➤ Greece says still awaiting EU/IMF response on proposal: Greece said on Wednesday its international creditors had failed to respond to its latest proposal on breaking an impasse over a cash-for-reforms deal, despite a plethora of negative comments in private from EU officials. Greece delayed a key debt payment to the International Monetary Fund on Friday, saying it would repay the money along with other payments due this month by the end of June.
 - WTI oil futures extend gains after bullish U.S. supply data: - West Texas Intermediate oil futures rose to the highest level in almost four weeks on Wednesday, after data showed that oil supplies in the U.S. fell for the sixth consecutive week last week.
 - Copper prices bounce off 6-week low on hopes for China stimulus: - Copper prices moved further away from a sixweek low on Tuesday, after disappointing Chinese inflation data added to speculation policymakers will have to introduce further stimulus measures to jumpstart the economy amid lackluster growth.
