

MARKET COMMENTARY

Indian equity benchmarks closed with moderate gain in Thursday's trade. Sentiments remained up-beat as above normal monsoon rains, stoking hopes that central bank will cut rates in October than in 2016 as anticipated earlier after delivering three cuts of 25 basis points each in 2015 so far. Meanwhile, Prime Minister Narendra Modi has launched smart cities, housing for all and urban rejuvenation schemes for Asia's third largest economy. Some support also came after the labour minister said the state social security fund would start investing in equity markets next month, as part of a reform drive aimed at boosting the economy. For today's trade nifty likely to trade in the range between 8420 – 8440 in the upper side and 8370 - 8350 in the lower side.

 - ➤ U.S. Stocks Fluctuate amid Hospital Shares Rally, Greek Talks: - U.S. stocks fluctuated, after the biggest drop in three weeks, as health-care shares rallied on a U.S. Supreme Court decision while investors watched for a breakthrough in Greek debt talks.
 - China Tech Stock Boom Falters as Traders Shun Soaring Valuations: - A rally in Chinese technology companies is reversing at the fastest pace in at least a year on concern valuations are too high relative to earnings growth.
 - Moody's Cuts HSBC Turkey to Junk as Gulliver Seeks Sale of Unit: - Moody's Investors Service cut the rating of HSBC Holdings Plc's Turkish unit as Chief Executive Officer Stuart Gulliver seeks a buyer for the unprofitable business. Moody's cut the long-term local and foreign currency deposit ratings of HSBC Bank AS to Ba1, the highest junk rating, from two levels and one level above junk respectively, it said in a statement late Wednesday. Both ratings have a negative outlook. As motivation for the moves, Moody's cited a potential reduction in support from the parent bank because of the sale process.

 - WTI oil futures fall below \$60 on U.S. supply outlook: West Texas Intermediate oil futures retreated on Thursday, as ongoing worries over high domestic U.S. oil production, despite a declining rig count, weighed.
