

MARKET COMMENTARY

Pressurized by weak global cues, Indian equity benchmarks ended the Monday's trade with a cut of over half a percent. Sentiments remained dampened after Greece and international creditors failed to come to an agreement over debt payments raised fears of Greece's exit from the euro zone. Investors also remained concerned over Finance Secretary Rajiv Mehrishi's statement that India is monitoring developments after the breakdown in talks between Greece and its creditors, but does not have a firm plan in place to deal with any significant fallout. Meanwhile, there was some cautiousness with Indian and Mauritian officials starting talks on proposed amendments to their bilateral tax treaty. For today's trade Nifty likely to trade in the range between 8340 – 8360 in the upper side and 8290 – 8270 in the lower side.

 - ➤ U.S. Stocks Retreat amid Concern on Fallout from Greek Crisis: U.S. stocks retreated, with the biggest drop in more than a month, amid mounting concern about fallout from a potential Greece exit from the euro area.
 - China's Stocks Enter Bear Market as Rate Cut Fails to Stop Rout: - Chinese stocks tumbled, sending the benchmark index into a bear market, as signs of an exodus by leveraged investors overshadowed the central bank's effort to revive confidence with an interest-rate cut.
 - ➤ Fed's Dudley Says September Rate Rise Possible after Better Data: - The Federal Reserve could begin raising interest rates in September if economic data continue to improve as they have in recent weeks, said William C. Dudley, president of the Federal Reserve Bank of New York.
 - Crude oil futures fall more than \$1 as Grexit fears mount: - Crude oil futures sold off on Monday, after emergency bailout talks between Greece and its international creditors broke down over the weekend, pushing Athens to the brink of a debt default and possible euro zone exit.
 - Greece default fears boost gold to 1week high: - Gold prices jumped to a one-week high on Monday, as Greece looked set to default on its debt repayment this week, boosting demand for safe-haven assets.
