

MARKET COMMENTARY

Markets finally got the much needed relief rally on Monday, with benchmarks not only reclaiming their crucial psychological levels but ending near the highs of the day. The trade which had turned sluggish by the mid of the day on domestic economic growth concern, suddenly got a new life after Euro zone leaders clinched a deal with Greece. Developments in Greece have been dictating stock moves worldwide since April. Sensex came very close to the crucial 28000 mark, while Nifty too posted nearly a triple digit rally, with across the board buying. For today's trade Nifty likely to trade in the range between 8470 – 8490 in the upper side and 8430 - 8410 in the lower side.

 - ➤ U.S. Stocks Rise after Greece Reaches Agreement with Creditors: - U.S. stocks advanced, with equities posting their best three-day rally since March, after Greece reached an agreement with its creditors.
 - ➤ Treasuries Drop after Greece Gets Deal as Focus Shifts to Fed: - Treasury 10-year notes fell, pushing yields to the highest level in more than two weeks, as Greece secured an agreement with creditors to stay in the euro.
 - Gold slips as investors remain cautious following preliminary Greek deal: - Gold futures fell mildly amid a stronger dollar, as Greece and its international creditors agreed in principal to a preliminary bailout early Monday morning following tense, often acrimonious marathon negotiations.
 - Oil declines as looming Iran nuclear deal, oversupply fears weigh: - Oil futures were lower on Monday, as traders awaited developments surrounding nuclear talks between the West and Iran, while concerns over a global supply glut weighed.
 - ➤ U.S. gas futures rise to 1-week high as forecasts turn warmer: - U.S. natural gas prices rose to a one-week high on Monday, as forecasts for the next two weeks turned warmer, boosting near-term demand expectations for the heating fuel.
 - Copper struggles near 6-year low after China metal imports decline: - Copper prices struggled near the lowest level in six years on Monday, after data showed that China's imports of the red metal slowed to a four-month low in May.
