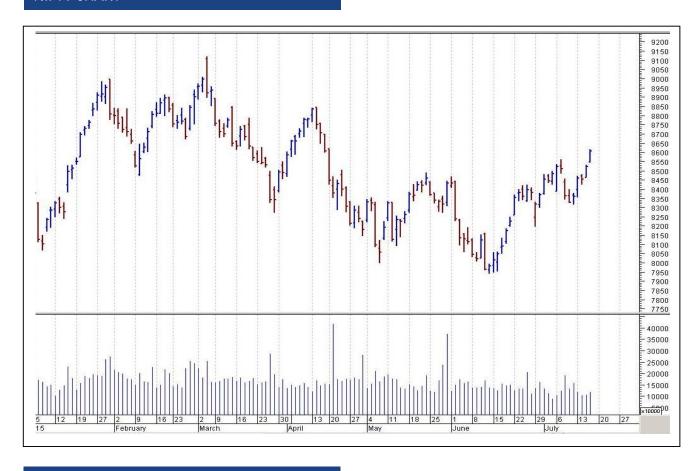

MARKET COMMENTARY

Snapping their three days gaining streak, Indian equity benchmarks ended the choppy day of trade with marginal losses on Monday as investors opted to book some profit off the table after couple of rallies. Domestic bourses after a positive start turned choppy and even went on to test important psychological 28,300 (Sensex) and 8,550 (Nifty) levels, but the key gauges got some support near those intraday low levels as they trimmed their losses from thereon as investors continued hunt for fundamentally strong stocks. Overall, sentiment on the street remained down-beat as marketmen remained on sidelines eying the monsoon session that begins Today in the Parliament. The NDA government will introduce eight new bills and take up 11 pending bills, including the controversial Land bill and the GST bill, for consideration and passage. For today's trade Nifty, likley to trade in the range between 8630 - 8650 in the upper side and 8580 – 8560 in the lower side.

 - ➤ U.S. Stocks Little Changed amid Earnings as Commodities Retreat: U.S. stocks were little changed, with the Standard & Poor's 500 Index near an all-time high, as better-than-forecast corporate results offset a slump in commodities producers. Hasbro Inc. jumped 6 percent on better-than-estimated earnings, while Halliburton Co. advanced 1.6 percent after its profit fell less than predicted. Newmont Mining Corp. lost 6.6 percent as gold fell to a five-year low, and Freeport-McMoRan Inc. sank 3.9 percent. Energy shares declined with oil prices.
 - ➤ Gold down 1.8% after plunging by as much as 5.3% in Asia: Gold prices came off the lowest levels of the session on Monday, after plunging to a five-year trough, amid speculation the Federal Reserve is moving closer to raising interest rates for the first time in eight years.
 - Copper declines, tracking losses in other metals: - Copper prices declined on Monday, tracking steep losses across the metals complex, as a broadly stronger U.S. dollar and expectations of higher interest rates in the U.S. weighed.
 - WTI oil futures fall to fresh 3-month low on supply outlook: - U.S. oil futures fell to the lowest level in more than three months on Monday, as ongoing worries over high domestic U.S. oil production, despite a declining rig count, weighed.
 - U.S. gas futures drop 2% in early trade as forecasts turn milder: - U.S. natural gas prices tumbled on Monday, as forecasts for the next two weeks turned milder, dampening near-term demand expectations for the cooling fuel.
