MARKET COMMENTARY

The Indian markets were badly butchered in the last session on P-Notes worries, amid global melt down. Yesterday, the start is likely to be weak on sluggish global cues and lacking any major supportive factor. Though, some consolidation and recovery can be seen in latter trade, as the Finance Minister Arun Jaitley has assured investors that the government will not take any action that may jeopardise investment climate. Traders will also get some support with Chief Economic Advisor (CEA) Arvind Subramanian stating that India can grow at 8-10 percent, provided exports put up a strong show, as he pointed that International economic environment on exports is not in India's favour as Europe, Japan and China are slowing. For today's trade Nifty likely to trade in the range between 8395 - 8410 in the upper side and 8340 – 8310 in the lower side.

 - ➤ U.S. Stocks Decline after China Shares Selloff on Growth Concern: - U.S. stocks fell, with equities headed for their longest losing streak since January, after the biggest slump in eight years for Chinese shares amid concern over the nation's economic growth.
 - China Rout Leads Stocks Lower as Dollar Drops, Treasuries Rise: - The biggest slump in Chinese shares in eight years led equities lower worldwide and selling spread to the dollar as the turmoil bolstered speculation the Federal Reserve will keep interest rates lower for longer.
 - ➤ U.S. gas futures turn higher after falling to 2-week low in early trade: -U.S. natural gas prices turned higher after falling to a two-week low on Monday, as market players assessed the outlook for U.S. demand and supply levels.
 - U.S. oil futures fall to 4-month low on rising rig count: - U.S. oil futures fell to a fresh four-month low on Monday, as lingering concerns over robust domestic oil production continued to drive down prices.
 - Copper tumbles to 6-year low amid China stock market melt-down: -Copper prices plunged to the lowest level in six years on Monday, as steep declines on Chinese stock markets dampened appetite for the red metal.
 - Gold futures trim gains after upbeat durable goods data: Gold prices trimmed gains on Monday to fall back below the \$1,100-level after data showed that U.S. durable goods orders rose more than expected in June, while core orders also topped forecasts, boosting optimism over the health of the economy and supporting the case for a U.S. interest rate hike this year.
