MARKET COMMENTARY

After hovering around the dotted line in the final hour of trade, the BSE-Sensex ended up closing lower by 47 points while NSE-Nifty closed lower by 13 points. However, midcaps and smallcaps bucked this trend and closed in positive. The S&P BSE Midcap was up by 0.4% while the S&P BSE Smallcap was up by 0.9%. Sectoral Indices ended the trading day on a mixed note. Gains were seen in stocks from the IT, consumer durables and capital goods sector, while profit booking was seen in metal, PSU and healthcare stocks.

For today's trade Nifty likely to trade in the range between 8490 - 8620 in the upper side and 8440 – 8330 in the lower side

 - ➤ U.S. Stocks Fluctuate as Commodities Slump Offsets Housing Data: - U.S. stocks fluctuated as a selloff in commodities that weighed on rawmaterials producers offset data showing improvement in the housing industry.
 - ➤ Housing Starts in U.S. Climb to an Almost Eight-Year High: New-home construction in the U.S. climbed in July to the highest level in almost eight years, indicating the industry will pick up in the second half of the year.
 - Copper tumbles to 6-year low amid China stock market melt-down: -Copper prices tumbled to the lowest level in more than six years on Tuesday, as steep declines on Chinese stock markets dampened appetite for the red metal.
 - WTI oil futures turn higher after upbeat U.S. housing data: - West Texas Intermediate oil futures bounced off the lowest level in more than six years on Tuesday to trade modestly higher after data showing that U.S. housing starts rose to an almost eight-year high in July.
 - ➤ Gold struggles for direction amid U.S. rate hike uncertainty: Gold prices swung between small gains and losses on Tuesday, as market players continued to speculate over the timing of a U.S. interest rate hike.
 - ➤ U.S. natural gas futures slide to 5week low as forecasts turn cooler: -U.S. natural gas prices slumped to the lowest level in more than five weeks on Tuesday, as forecasts for cooler weather across key consumption regions of the U.S. in the week ahead dampened demand expectations for the fuel.
