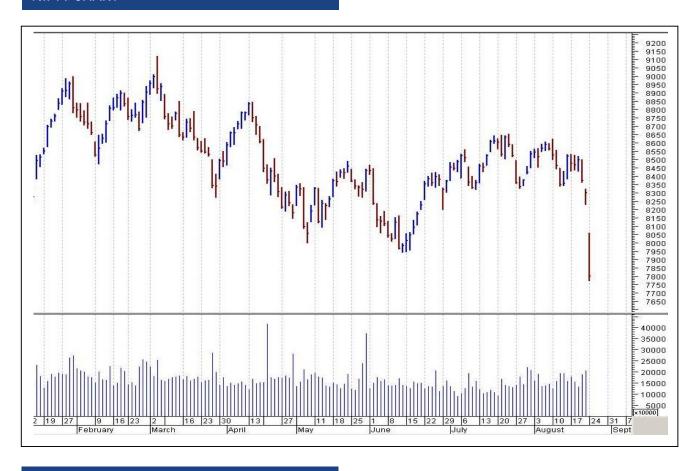

MARKET COMMENTARY

Monday's trading session turned out to be a daunting one for stock markets in India and benchmarks ended below their crucial 7,850 (Nifty) and 25,800 (Sensex) levels, following fears of a slowdown in the Chinese economy on expectations of tapering demand for goods and services worldwide going forward. After a gap-down opening, the domestic bourses never looked in recovery mood and ended the trade near ten months lows with a huge cut of around six percent, making it the biggest crash in about seven years on a global rout and the third biggest-ever for the BSE benchmark index. Selling was both brutal and wide-based as none of sectoral indices on BSE were spared. Counters, which featured in the list of worst performers, include realty, oil and gas and power. For today's trade Nifty likely to trade in the range between 7850 – 7900 in the upper side and 7750 – 7700 in the lower side.

 - Wall Street in free-fall; all three indexes in correction: - Wall Street opened sharply lower on Monday with the Dow Jones industrial average losing more than a 1,000 points following a more-than 8 percent drop in Chinese shares and a selloff in oil and other commodities.
 - ➤ Great fall of China sinks world stocks, dollar tumbles: Alarm bells rang across world markets on Monday as a near 9 percent dive in China shares and a sharp drop in the dollar and major commodities panicked investors. European stocks were almost 3 percent in the red and Wall Street was braced for similar losses after Asian shares slumped to 3-year lows as a three month-long rout in Chinese equities threatened to get out of hand.
 - ➤ Dollar extends losses against euro, yen: The dollar extended losses against the yen and the euro on Monday, after steep falls in Chinese equities overnight added to fears that the world's second-largest economy is slowing and added to doubts over how soon the Federal Reserve will hike interest rates.
 - Oil plunges to fresh 6-1/2 year low as panic grips the market: - Oil futures sank to levels not seen since the peak of the global financial crisis in 2009 on Monday, as steep declines on China's stock market rattled investors' confidence.
 - Gold climbs to fresh 7-week high as global equities, U.S. dollar tumble: -Gold prices rose to a fresh seven-week high on Monday, as heavy losses in global equity markets and the U.S. dollar boosted demand for the yellow metal.
 - U.S. natural gas futures slide to 11week low as forecasts turn cooler: -U.S. natural gas prices slumped to an 11week low on Monday, as forecasts for mild weather.
