# **MARKET COMMENTARY**

Indian markets extended their jubilation on Wednesday with gains of around one and half a percent and while Nifty reclaimed the crucial psychological level of 7950 intraday, Sensex surged past 26000 to its highest level in a week, supported by positive global trends. However, the euphoria of RBI unexpectedly cutting the key policy rates by 50 basis points kept making its impact on the markets and rate sensitives strengthened further. The central bank had also hiked limit for FPI investment in government bonds to 5 per cent of the outstanding stock by March, 2018, a move that will bring in an additional Rs 1.2 lakh crore in G-Sec. For today's trade Nifty likely to trade in the range between 7970 – 7990 in the upper side and 7920 – 7900 in the lower side.

  - ➤ Stock Gains Trim Quarter's \$11 Trillion Rout as Bonds, Yen Drop: - From stocks to commodities to emerging-market currencies, traders got a measure of solace at the end of the most volatile quarter for financial markets since 2011.
  - ➤ Senate Passes U.S. Spending Bill Hours before Shutdown Deadline: The Senate passed a U.S. government spending plan hours before a shutdown deadline, sending the bill to the House where Speaker John Boehner promised a vote over objections from fellow Republicans who wanted to use it to defund Planned Parenthood. The measure, which continues to fund Planned Parenthood, passed the Senate 78-20 on Wednesday.
  - Russia Starts Syrian Air Strikes in Support of Putin Ally Assad: - President Vladimir Putin began air strikes to support his beleaguered Syrian ally Bashar al-Assad in Russia's first use of force in the Middle East since the 1980s.
  - ➤ Gold falls to 2-week low after upbeat ADP jobs report: Gold futures extended losses to hit a two-week low on Wednesday, after data showed U.S. nonfarm private employment rose more than expected in September, boosting optimism over the health of the economy and supporting the case for a U.S. interest rate hike this year.
  - ➤ U.S. natural gas futures slump as market awaits storage report: U.S. natural gas futures declined on Wednesday, as market participants looked ahead to fresh weekly information on U.S. gas inventories to gauge the strength of demand for the fuel.
  - Copper futures rise ahead of key China factory data.
