MARKET COMMENTARY

Extending their northward journey for sixth day in a row, Indian equity benchmarks ended the volatile session in the green with a gain of around one third of a percent on hopes of rollout of the Goods and Services Tax (GST) from the next financial year. Markets gave up their entire gains in noon deals and entered into red terrain as sentiments weakened on report that International Monetary Fund (IMF) has cut its global growth forecasts for a second time this year, citing weak commodity prices and a slowdown in China and warned that policies aimed at increasing demand were needed. IMF has also lowered India's growth forecast to 7.3 per cent this year, from its earlier estimate of 7.5 per cent, and said that a faster-than-expected deceleration in inflation provides leeway for modest cuts in interest rates. For today's trade Nifty likely to trade in the range between 8210 – 8230 in the upper side and 8150 – 8130 inthe lower side.

 - Emerging Market Assets Gain with Commodities; U.S. Stocks Mixed: -Emerging-market assets surged as a rebound in commodities persisted amid a weaker dollar. U.S. stocks pared earlier gains as oil's rally ended following a rise in inventories.
 - IMF cuts global growth forecasts again, cites commodity and China worries: - The International Monetary Fund cut its global growth forecasts for a second time this year on Tuesday, citing weak commodity prices and a slowdown in China and warned that policies aimed at increasing demand were needed.
 - ▶ Bank of Japan Leaves Stimulus Package Unchanged: - The Bank of Japan (BOJ) held off on expanding its stimulus package Wednesday, despite growing signs of recession in the country's economy. Japan, hit by a slowdown in China, is said to be in technical recession and core consumer prices in August witnessed their first annual drop since the central bank deployed its massive stimulus program over two years ago.
 - ➤ U.S. Oil approaching \$50 Boosts Stocks as Emerging Markets Surge: -Stocks rose around the world as U.S. oil approached \$50 a barrel for the first time since July, spurring gains in emerging markets and the currencies of commodityproducing nations.
 - ➤ Gold relatively flat, as investors await release of Fed's Sept. minutes: Gold futures were relatively unchanged on Wednesday amid a flat dollar, ahead of the release of the minutes of the Federal Open Market Committee's September meeting on Thursday afternoon.
