

MARKET COMMENTARY

Extending southward journey for third straight session, Indian equity benchmarks ended the choppy day of trade slightly in red. Sentiments remained dampened after IT bellwether Tata Consultancy Services' (TCS) second-quarter revenue missed street expectation, raising concerns that the company may not be able to continue its trend in coming quarters too. For the quarter ended September 30, TCS' revenue grew 3% sequentially, or 5.8% year-over-year. Meanwhile, the WPI inflation data released during the day indicated a mild uptick of 0.51 per cent in the September WPI inflations, which stood at -4.54 per cent against -4.95 per cent in August. The wholesale fuel prices fell 17.71% from a year ago. Prices of manufactured goods declined 1.73% on year in September. Food prices, however, inched up 0.69% year-on-year last month. For today's trade Nifty likely to trade in the range between 8135 - 8155 in the upper side and 80 90 – 8070 in the lower side.

 - Stocks, Dollar Drop as China Data Damp Fed Rate Bets; Bonds Rise: -Sliding stocks and a depreciating dollar show the market's takeaway from disappointing Chinese data is that the Federal Reserve will keep interest rates lower for longer.
 - ➢ Global equities fell for a second day after Chinese factory-gate prices matched their biggest slump since the global financial crisis. Government bonds gained and the greenback weakened against almost all major peers as the odds of a U.S. rate hike this year tumbled to 34 percent. Copper and nickel fell, while U.S. crude oil traded below \$47 a barrel.
 - The dollar depreciated while gold and bonds strengthened on speculation slowing global growth will encourage the Federal Reserve to keep interest rates lower for longer. U.S. stocks fluctuated as earnings season picked up momentum.
 - WTI oil futures fall to 8-day low ahead of API weekly supply report: - West Texas Intermediate oil futures rebounded on Tuesday, as market players looked ahead to fresh weekly information on U.S. stockpiles of crude and refined products to gauge the strength of demand in the world's largest oil consumer.
 - ➢ Gold futures shoot higher after weak U.S. retail sales data: - Gold futures jumped to a three-month high on Wednesday, after data showed retail sales in the U.S. rose less than expected in September, dampening optimism over the strength of the economy and dimming the case for higher interest rates.
