# **MARKET COMMENTARY**

Tuesday's session turned out to be a fabulous day of trade for the Indian equity markets, where bulls maintained momentum for second consecutive session, garnering a gain of around half a percent. Hectic buying activity which took place during second half of trade mainly drove the markets higher, with frontline gauges ending near their crucial 25,900 (Sensex) and 7,850 (Nifty) mark. After a gap-up opening, marketmen booked all their initial gains at higher levels amid report that India's merchandise exports dipped for the 11th month in a row and stood at \$21.35 billion, down by 17.33 percent, due to weak global demands. However, the data showed trade deficit narrowed to \$9.8 billion in October compared with \$10.5 billion in the previous month. For today's trade Nifty likely to trade in the range between 7850 - 7880 in the upper side and 7810 – 7790 in the lower side.

  - ➤ Stocks Rise as Energy Slump Eases; Dollar Rises, Treasuries Drop: - U.S. stocks resumed a rebound from the worst week since August as a rout in energy shares eased. Firming inflation in the U.S. reinforced speculation the Federal Reserve will raise rates next month, triggering a selloff in Treasuries and boosting the dollar.
  - ➤ Dollar Climbs to 7-Month High as Inflation Seen Endorsing Fed: - The dollar climbed to a seven-month high against the euro before data that economists forecast to show inflation quickening in the U.S. amid speculation the Federal Reserve will raise interest rates from near zero as soon as next month.
  - ➤ Euro's Seven-Month Low Fuels Equity Rally as Metals Drop Deepens: -Diverging monetary policy in Europe and the U.S. sent the euro to a seven-month low against the dollar, boosting stocks in the region and deepening a selloff in metals.
  - Commodities Rout Weighs on U.S. Stocks as Bonds Fall on Fed Bets: -Firming inflation in the U.S. reinforced speculation the Federal Reserve will raise rates next month, triggering a selloff in Treasuries and boosting the dollar. Commodities from oil to copper resumed a slide.
  - WTI oil prices fall below \$41 ahead of API weekly supply report: - West Texas Intermediate oil futures declined in volatile trade on Tuesday, as market players looked ahead to fresh weekly information on U.S. stockpiles of crude and refined products to gauge the strength of demand in the world's largest oil consumer.
  - ➤ U.S. natural gas futures slide 3% as forecasts turn milder.
