MARKET COMMENTARY

Indian markets after surging in last two sessions, suffered sharp setback on Wednesday with major averages losing around a percent and half in frenzied selling in the second half of the trade. Intermittent profit taking at higher levels that was being witnessed in first half turned into sharp selling. Traders grew concerned with heavy gunfire erupting in a north Paris suburb, as special police forces launched an operation to catch the alleged mastermind behind gun and bomb attacks in which 129 people were killed last week. Back on street, apart from profit-booking in recent gainers, absence of any positive cues mainly dragged the indices down. The weakness in rupee that depreciated considerably against the dollar on buying of the US currency by importers, too weighed on the sentiments. For today's trade Nifty likely to trade in the range between 7745 – 7765 in the upper side and 7710 – 7680 in the lower side.

 - ➤ U.S. Stocks Rise, Dollar Falls as Fed Signals Gradual Rate Hike: - U.S. stocks rose and the dollar slipped from a sevenmonth high versus the euro amid speculation Federal Reserve meeting minutes will reinforce that interest-rate increases will be gradual as the economy improves.
 - Treasuries fall before Fed Minutes; Metals Drop, Crude Oil Gains: -Treasuries slid and German bunds erased gains before the release of minutes from the Federal Reserve's last policy meeting. European stocks pared declines and futures on U.S. equity indexes rose.
 - The BOJ Is Done Boosting Stimulus, More Economists Say: - Governor Haruhiko Kuroda, who unleashed unprecedented monetary stimulus at the Bank of Japan in 2013 and doubled down on it last year, is done expanding his efforts, according to an increasing number of economists.
 - China's Steel Industry Peers into Abyss as Output to Plunge: - Crude steel production in China will collapse by 23 million metric tons next year, according to the nation's leading industry group. That's equivalent to more than a quarter of annual output from the U.S.
 - ➤ U.S. housing starts fall to sevenmonth low, permits rise: - U.S. housing starts in October fell to a seven-month low as single-family home construction in the South tumbled, but a surge in building permits suggested the housing market remained on solid ground.
