MARKET COMMENTARY

Indian markets got a muted start of the F&O expiry week and the Sensex and Nifty struggled to retain their crucial psychological levels, with weakness in FMCG and metal stocks putting pressure on the overall market movement for the day. Barring the final hours of volatility the trade remained mostly range-bound with benchmarks moving near the neutral line. Markets lacked any direction from the very beginning with Asian peers too showing a subdued trend. Traders remained concerned with global rating agency Standard & Poor's statement that India's rating could come under stress if government fails to pursue reforms agenda and overshoots fiscal deficit target. It has ruled out a rating upgrade for the country in the next 12-18 months but said that in case the government is able to get the Goods and Services Tax (GST) bill passed in the forthcoming Winter Session of Parliament, it would be a credit positive. For today's trade Nifty likely to trade in the range between 7865 – 7895 in the upper side and 7830 - 7810 in the lower side.

 - ➤ Oil Resumes Gains on Saudi Pledge as Stocks Rise, Copper Slides: - Oil resumed gains after Saudi Arabia repeated it's ready to work with other producers to stabilize global markets. Copper led other commodities lower while U.S. stocks advanced following their best weekly performance of the year.
 - Fed's Own Dollar Index Gives Yellen Reason to Raise Rates Slowly: - The surge in the dollar that helped convince the Federal Reserve to refrain from raising interest rates until at least December also supports the notion that it will be a shallow path higher.
 - Euro falls to 7-month lows on ECB easing expectations: - The euro fell to the lowest level in seven months against the dollar on Monday amid heightened expectations that the European Central Bank will scale up its monetary easing program next month.
 - Copper slides to fresh 6-year low as collapse continues: - Copper prices fell to the lowest level since May 2009 on Monday, as the possibility of higher interest rates in the U.S., a broadly stronger U.S. dollar and slower global economic growth, especially in China, weighed.
 - Oil spikes higher after bullish Saudi comments: - Oil prices rebounded from earlier losses to spike higher on Monday, after Saudi Arabia said it is prepared to use all measures necessary to ensure a stable oil market. The world's biggest oil producer added that it is ready to cooperate with OPEC and non-OPEC producers in order to stabilize prices.
