MARKET COMMENTARY

Wednesday's session turned out to be a choppy day of trade for the domestic markets, where key indices got off to a positive start, but surrendered all their gains soon to languish into the negative terrain thereafter in the absence of any positive trigger. Though, some amount of recovery was witnessed in last leg of trade but it was not enough to pull benchmarks into positive trajectory. Traders remained concerned with Reserve Bank of India (RBI)-sponsored survey of professional forecasters stating that the retail inflation is likely to rise to 5.5 per cent in the last quarter of this fiscal and thereafter may moderate to 5.2 per cent by September 2016. Though, the forecasters expect real Gross Value Added at basic price (GVA) to increase by 7.4 per cent in 2015-16. For today's trade Nifty likely to trade in the range between 7950 – 7970 in the upper side and 7910 – 7870 in the lower side.

 - Treasuries fall, Dollar Strengthens on Jobs Data; Oil Declines: - Treasuries fell and the dollar rose as data showed a strengthening U.S. labor market and tepid inflation in Europe, kicking off three days of economic events likely to set the course for global markets into 2016.
 - Crude Oil Declines as OPEC Ministers Gather for Policy Meeting: - Oil decreased for the third time in four days as ministers from the Organization of Petroleum Exporting Countries arrive in Vienna to discuss production policy. Futures slipped as much as 2.6 percent in New York amid a broader decline in commodities. Prices briefly rose after the Iranian Oil Ministry's Shana news agency said a majority of OPEC members agree on reduction in output, with the exception of Saudi Arabia and Persian Gulf Arab countries. U.S. crude stockpiles climbed to 489.4 million barrels last week, the highest for this time of year since 1930, government data show.
 - Gold firms above 6-year low ahead of U.S. data, Yellen comments: - Gold prices inched higher on Wednesday, as investors awaited key U.S. data later in the day for further indications on the strength of the economy and the likelihood of a near-term interest rate hike.
 - Copper trades near 1-week high on China production cuts: - Copper prices traded near a one-week high on Wednesday, after Chinese metal producers pledged to cut production of the red metal to combat falling prices.
 - Yellen Expected to Spell out Gradual Pace of Rate Hikes.
