

## MARKET COMMENTARY

A session after displaying a distressing performance, Indian benchmark indices managed to pull through a scintillating performance by vivaciously rallying around a percent on Wednesday, thanks to the hefty short covering in the beaten down blue chip counters. Sentiments got some support with the report that the government is likely to meet its fiscal deficit target of 3.9 per cent of the GDP for the current financial year, largely on account of the latest round of excise duty hikes on oil products and marginal compression in expenditure. For today's trade Nifty likely to trade in the range between 7115 - 7135 in the upper side and 7075 – 7045 in the lower side.

  - ➤ U.S., European Stocks Gain with Oil as Treasuries, Yen Retreat: U.S. and European stocks gained amid speculation that the recent selloff was overdone, as investors looked past losses in Asian markets triggered by a weakening yuan. Crude rose.
  - ➤ Dollar stronger after US data while waiting for Fed minutes: In an immediate reaction to the publication of US data on Wednesday, the dollar strengthened positions against major currencies as a surprise increase in producer prices (PPI) appeared to outweigh some negative figures on the American housing market and investors await the publication of the minutes from the Federal Reserve's latest meeting.
  - ➤ BOJ May Add to Stimulus at March Meeting, Abe Adviser Says: The Bank of Japan should act preemptively to change the deflationary mindset in Japan and this action could come as soon as March, said Etsuro Honda, an adviser to Prime Minister Shinzo Abe.
  - ➤ U.S. housing starts fall; producer prices nudge up: U.S. housing starts unexpectedly fell in January likely as bad weather disrupted building activity in some parts of the country, in what could be a temporary setback for the housing market recovery. Other data on Wednesday showed producer prices rose last month and there were signs of an uptick in underlying producer inflation. Inflation is being watched closely for signs of whether the Federal Reserve will raise interest rates this year.
  - Oil higher with I ran output talks in focus: - Oil prices rise on hopes for deal to freeze production levels. Iran was to hold talks with OPEC but indicated it would take a tough line on freezing production.
