

MARKET COMMENTARY

Extending their winning streak for the second day in a row, Indian equity benchmarks ended the session with a gain of over a percent on Thursday. It turned out to be a rather volatile day of trade as the indices rebounded after drifting to lower levels in the noon session and sustained position build up was witnessed across the board. Sentiments got a boost after global ratings agency Moody's Investors Service rehashed faith in the Indian economy. According to agency, country's economy will grow at 7.5% in 2016 and 2017 as it is relatively less exposed to external headwinds, like China slowdown, and will benefit from lower commodity prices. Some support also came with the report that India's current account deficit (CAD), is likely to narrow to 0.7 per cent of GDP in the current financial year from 1.3 per cent in FY'15. For today's trade Nifty likely to trade in the range between 7215 – 7235 in the upper side and 7165 – 7145 in the lower side.



 - ➤ Global Stocks Extend Gains as Oil Rebound Buoys Emerging Markets: Stocks worldwide climbed to a two-week high, as a rebound in oil lifted emerging market shares and U.S. economic data topped estimates. Treasuries rose to halt a three-day drop.
 - ➤ China's yuan traded onshore appreciated 0.19 percent. The People's Bank of China said it will move to daily open-market operations, vowing to improve efficiency by increasing frequency. Separately, the PBOC was said to offer to reduce the medium-term borrowing cost it charges lenders in the second such move this year.
 - ➤ WTI oil futures off the highs after weekly stockpile data: West Texas Intermediate oil came off the highest levels of the session in North America trade on Thursday, after data showed that oil supplies in the U.S. rose less than expected last week. The U.S. Energy Information Administration said in its weekly report that crude oil inventories increased by 2.1 million barrels in the week ended February 12. Market analysts' expected a crude-stock rise of 3.9 million barrels, while the American Petroleum Institute late Wednesday reported a supply drop of 3.3 million barrels.
 - Natural gas prices struggle near 2-month lows after U.S. storage data: -U.S. natural gas futures struggled near the lowest level in two months in North America trade on Thursday, despite data showing that U.S. natural gas supplies in storage fell more than expected last week. The U.S. Energy Information Administration said in its weekly report that natural gas storage in the U.S. in the week ended February 12 fell by 158 billion cubic feet, more than expectations
