MARKET COMMENTARY

Indian equity indices showcased yet another euphoric performance and went on to outclass indices around the world by vivaciously rallying by over a percentage points in the session and settling above the psychological 7,700 (Nifty) and 25,200 (Sensex) levels. Friday's optimism got spilled over into the new week, helping the frontline indices in extending the winning momentum for second successive session on Monday as hopes increased that Reserve Bank of India (RBI) could cut rates by as much as 50 basis points next month after the government slashed the country's retail savings rate last week. Sentiments got some support from a report, indicating growth prospects remain positive for the Indian economy, with the government strongly accelerating its reform announcements. According to the report, the real estate Bill, the new Hydrocarbon Exploration Licensing Policy, the Bill to amend the Companies Act and the proposed introduction of the bankruptcy code bear testimony that the government is well focused on reviving the investment climate and improving ease of doing business scenario in India. For today's trade Nifty likely to trade in the range between 7685 – 7665 in the upper side and 7735 – 7755 in the lower side.

 - ➤ U.S. Stocks Mixed as Global Volatility Wanes, Treasuries Fall: - Volatility across global financial markets is at a two-month low as signs central banks will keep borrowing costs lower for longer settle investor nerves that frayed at the start of the year.
 - ➢ Gold falls below \$1,250 ahead of Fed speakers: Gold futures were lower in North American trade on Monday, as market players awaited comments from a pair of Federal Reserve officials later in the session for further clues on the path of future rate hikes. Following last week's dovish Fed meeting, the market will be paying attention to FOMC member speeches to judge the balance of opinion among policymakers on the prospect of further rate hikes.
 - Oil prices edge up from day's lows; supply freeze talks in focus: - Oil prices rallied on Monday, reversing earlier losses, as the market digested news of a modest rise in U.S. drilling activity, though uncertainty lingered over the outcome of a meeting of the world's major exporters next month to discuss freezing output. U.S. energy firms last week added one oil rig after 12 weeks of cuts, according to data from industry firm Baker Hughes.
 - ➤ U.S. natural gas futures pull further away from 1-month top: U.S. natural gas futures were lower in North American trade on Monday, moving further away from last week's one-month high as spring-like temperatures and a widening supply glut weighed. Natural gas prices have closely tracked weather forecasts in recent weeks, as traders try to gauge the impact of shifting outlooks on late-winter heating demand.
