### **MARKET COMMENTARY**

Buying activity which took place during last leg of trade mainly drove the markets higher and key domestic benchmarks managed to keep their head above water on Tuesday. Markets traded choppy for most part of the day's trade, as traders remained concerned with slow growth of the manufacturing activity, as the yearly SBI Composite Index for March has declined below 50 and is at 49.5, compared with last month index of 51.3. Depreciation in Indian rupee too dampened sentiments. For today's trade Nifty likely to trade in the range between 7735 – 7765 in the upper side and 7685 – 7645 in the lower side.

  - ➤ Stocks Pare Losses After Brussels Attack as Gold, Bonds Advance: - U.S. stocks were little changed, as investors dived into safer assets like Treasuries, gold and defensive shares after deadly terrorist attacks in Brussels killed at least 31 people.
  - European Stocks Drop after Brussels Explosions; Gold, Yen Rise: - European stocks fell the most in a week, while German government bonds rose with gold and the yen after explosions rocked Brussels airport.
  - ➤ U.S. natural gas futures sink to 1week low: - natural gas futures were lower in North American trade on Tuesday, hitting a one-week low as updated weather forecasting models pointed to spring-like temperatures across most parts of the U.S. in the weeks ahead. Natural gas prices have closely tracked weather forecasts in recent weeks, as traders try to gauge the impact of shifting outlooks on late-winter heating demand.
  - Libya joins I ran in snubbing oil freeze: source: - Libya does not plan to attend an April 17 meeting of oil producers about freezing supply to support prices, a Libyan OPEC delegate said on Tuesday, joining fellow OPEC member I ran in snubbing the initiative.
  - ➢ Gold rallies after multiple explosions hit Brussels: Gold futures rallied in North American trade on Tuesday, as a series of explosions in Brussels sparked a wave of risk aversion, boosting appetite for safe-haven assets. Risk sentiment took a hit after explosions tore through the departure hall of Brussels airport on Tuesday morning killing at least 26 people and injuring 35 others and a second blast struck a metro station in the capital shortly afterwards.
