

### **MARKET COMMENTARY**

Monday turned out to be a fabulous day of trade for Indian equity benchmarks, where frontline gauges garner over half a percent gain in volatile session of trade. Sensex ended just shy of its crucial 25,400 mark, while Nifty regained its psychological level of 7,750. Earlier, markets failed to hold on to their initial gains and entered into red terrain in noon deals as investors remained on sidelines ahead of the Reserve Bank of India's (RBI) monetary policy review due tomorrow. The selling proved short lived and markets once again gained momentum in last leg of trade to end the session near intraday highs. For today's trade Nifty likely to trade intherange between 7785 – 7795 in the upper side and 7735 – 7725 in the lower side.

  - ➤ U.S. Stocks Slip as Dollar Gains with Natural Gas; Oil Retreats: - U.S. stocks slipped from the highest levels of the year, while the dollar and Treasuries were little changed as investors assessed the potential for central-bank stimulus to boost flagging global growth.
  - ➤ Lagarde Says IMF Greek Deal Far Off as Talks Roiled by Leaks: -International Monetary Fund Managing Director Christine Lagarde rebuffed Greek government calls to replace top officials overseeing the country's bailout and said the IMF is "a good distance away" from an agreement that would allow for additional loans to Europe's most indebted state.
  - ➤ Gold declines amid Fed rate hike uncertainty: Gold futures declined in European trade on Monday, as better than expected U.S. employment data sparked speculation the Federal Reserve could raise interest rates sooner and faster than expected.
  - Oil touches one-month low on skepticism over potential freeze deal: - Oil held around its lowest in a month on Monday as investors ditched some of their bullish bets on another price rise and the chances that top exporters will agree to rein in overproduction appeared to fade.
  - ▶ U.S. cold burst drives natural gas futures to more than 7-week high: U.S. natural gas futures soared to a more than seven-week high on Monday, as updated weather forecasting models pointed to a burst of chillier-than-normal weather across most parts of the U.S. in the coming days. Midwestern and Northeastern temperatures are expected to fall below normal in the first week in April amid a late season cold front, while a fast warm-up in the west is expected to drive cooling demand.
