MARKET COMMENTARY

There was hardly any relief for the Indian markets after being butchered in the last session, as the benchmarks after a strong start on supportive Asian market cues lost their direction and showed a volatile trade throughout the session, moving in and out of the red zone. Markets lacked conviction from the very beginning and faced intermittent profit taking at the higher levels. Traders even overlooked report of private sector activity in the country, which registered a significant uptrend and surged to a 37-month high in March. Indian services companies remain optimistic that activity will increase further over the coming 12 months. There was some strength in rate sensitive stocks after RBI Deputy Governor S S Mundra, a day after the central bank cut policy rate by 0.25 per cent, expressed hope that transmission of lower interest rate through banks will be more effective this time. For today's trade Nifty likely to trade in the range between 7635 – 7665 in the upper side and 7585 – 7565 in the lower side.

 - Stocks Rise on Crude Rally as Dollar Mixed before Fed Minutes: - Stocks rebounded from a three-week low after crude oil added to gains on U.S. inventory data, while the dollar erased a gain amid persistent concern that the global economy remains vulnerable to slowing growth in China.
 - WTI oil futures extend gains as crude stocks fall 4.9M barrels: West Texas Intermediate oil futures added to sharp gains in North America trade on Wednesday, after data showed that oil supplies in the U.S. fell for the first time in eight weeks last week. The U.S. Energy Information Administration said in its weekly report that crude oil inventories fell by 4.9 million barrels in the week ended April 1. Market analysts' expected a crude-stock rise of 3.2 million barrels, while the American Petroleum Institute late Tuesday reported a supply drop of 4.3 million barrels.
 - ➤ U.S. natural gas futures under pressure ahead of storage report: U.S. natural gas futures fell to a more than one-week low on Wednesday, as traders looked ahead to fresh weekly information on U.S. gas inventories to gauge the strength of demand for the fuel. The U.S. Energy Information Administration's storage report slated for release on Thursday is expected to show a build of approximately 7 billion cubic feet for the week ending April 1.
 - ➢ Gold drops below \$1,225 with FOMC minutes in focus: Gold futures were lower in North American trade on Wednesday, extending overnight losses as market players awaited the release of minutes from the Federal Reserve's March policy meeting for fresh clues on the timing of the next U.S. rate hike.
