

MARKET COMMENTARY

Indian stock markets have prolonged the lull for second straight day and finished the session on a disappointing note, as investors lacked conviction to pile up fresh positions. The optimism in domestic markets petered out completely by the end of trade and the benchmarks even drifted in to the negative territory in last lag of trade despite getting off to a gap-up opening. Marketmen looked optimistic for most part of the session as global sentiments remained upbeat and most markets in Asia rallied amid a strong gain in global crude oil prices. For today's trade Nifty likely to trade in the range between 7935 – 7965 in the upper side and 7885 – 7865 in the lower side.

 - ➤ U.S. Stocks Falls Along With Oil; Euro Erases Gain after Draghi: U.S. stocks retreated with crude prices, while the euro erased an advance after the European Central Bank kept interest rates unchanged at its latest policy meeting.
 - Commodity prices halted a three-day rebound that was spurred by supply cuts and signs of a pickup in Chinese growth. The recent resurgence in raw-material prices would be a boon to the ECB, which refrained from easing policy further on Thursday after unleashing unprecedented stimulus measures in March to revive growth. Draghi said at a briefing that the central bank will step up stimulus if the outlook for the euro area worsens. In the U.S., investors are also weighing a mix of corporate earnings that haven't provided investors with a clearer picture on the economic outlook.
 - ➤ ECB's Draghi Defiant after Central Bank Keeps Rates on Hold: - Europe's top central banker struck a defiant tone Thursday over German-led criticism that the European Central Bank has overstepped the mark in its ultra-low interest rate policies. After the bank's decision to keep its interest rates unchanged at record lows, ECB President Mario Draghi said the bank can deploy more stimulus if global troubles threaten to push a modest economic recovery off the rails and further weighs on inflation.
 - Oil turns lower after early gains in volatile trade: - Oil prices turned lower on Thursday, reversing early strong gains in a volatile trading session as a stronger dollar weighed.
 - Natural gas moves higher despite storage data: - U.S. <u>natural gas</u> prices moved higher on Thursday, despite data showing that stockpiles rose more than expected last week.
