

MARKET COMMENTARY

Indian equity benchmarks ended the choppy day of trade with a cut of around half a percent on Wednesday owing to persistent selling by the FIIs amid weakness in global peers. Markets tried to regain green terrain couple of time but effort went in vain and key gauges ended in red with key gauges somehow managing to hold their crucial 7,700 (Nifty) and 25,100 (Sensex) levels. Sentiments remained down-beat after growth in India's services firms fell to a four-month low of 53.7 in April from 54.3 in March on the back of new business growing slower than the previous months. For today's trade Nifty likely to trade in the range between 7735 - 7765 in the upper side and 7695 – 7665 in the lower side.

 - Dollar Strengthens on Fed Caution as U.S. Stocks Fall Second Day: - The dollar strengthened and U.S. stocks slid a second day after comments by Federal Reserve officials signaled that an interestrate hike may occur sooner than the market has been anticipating.
 - Dollar broadly higher after positive U.S. data: - The dollar remained broadly higher against the other major currencies on Wednesday, after the release of mostly positive U.S. data boosted optimism over the strength of the economy.
 - ➤ U.S. crude stockpiles rise more than expected to fresh record high: EIA: U.S. crude oil stockpiles rose more than expected to fresh record highs last week as imports ticked higher, while gasoline inventories posted a surprise build as refineries ramped up production, data from the Energy Information Administration showed on Wednesday. Crude inventories rose 2.8 million barrels in the week to April 29 to 543.4 million barrels, building by about a million barrels more than analysts' expectations.
 - ➤ U.S. natural gas futures rally 3% ahead of storage data: U.S. natural gas futures were higher for the second straight day on Wednesday, as traders looked ahead to fresh weekly information on U.S. gas inventories to gauge the strength of demand for the fuel.
 - ➤ Gold slid a third day, as the dollar's rebound dimmed the metal's appeal as an alternative investment. Bullion for immediate delivery retreated 0.4 percent to \$1,281.24 an ounce. Copper fell 1 percent to \$4,873 a metric ton and zinc dropped 0.3 percent.
