### **MARKET COMMENTARY**

The Indian markets once again showed a volatile trade and despite coming off the early slump, ended lower by over half a percent in last session. Today, the start is likely to remain somber as the global cues too are subdued. There will be buzz in the markets with Rajya Sabha clearing the bankruptcy bill, after it was passed by Lok Sabha last week. The bill is expected to further enhance the ease of doing business in the country. Traders will be getting some support with Finance Ministry's statement amid concerns on how markets will react to the decision taken by India to tax capital gains from Mauritius that India will continue to attract investments because of the inherent strength and the return it offers to investors.

  - U.S. Stocks Fall on Retailer Slump, Crude Gains as Dollar Slips: - U.S. stocks slipped after the biggest gain in two months, as disappointing results from Walt Disney Co. to Macy's Inc. raised doubts about the strength of the American consumer. Metals advanced as the dollar retreated.
  - Dollar remains broadly lower in subdued trade: - The dollar remained broadly lower against the other major currencies on Wednesday, as investors continued to lock in profits from the greenback's recent gains, especially against the yen after Japan warned that it is prepared to intervene in the foreign exchange market.
  - Gold climbs off 2-week lows to reclaim \$1,270 as dollar takes a breather: Gold futures were higher in European trade on Wednesday, after falling to the lowest level in almost two weeks overnight, as investors continued to monitor movements in the U.S. dollar. The dollar index, which measures the greenback's strength against a tradeweighted basket of six major currencies, halted its six-day win streak in early trade Wednesday, falling to 93.99 after climbing to 94.33 a day earlier, which was the most since April 28.
  - ➤ U.S. crude stockpiles fall for first time in six weeks: EIA: U.S. crude stockpiles fell unexpectedly last week for the first time since March as imports slipped, U.S. government data showed on Wednesday, after a wildfire curtailed production in Canada, the top source of U.S. oil imports. Gasoline and distillate inventories also dropped more than expected, as refining rates fell, data from the Energy Information Administration showed. Crude inventories fell 3.4 MB.
