MARKET COMMENTARY

It was a lackadaisical performance from the Indian benchmark indices on Tuesday, as they failed to snap the session in the green territory and settled marginally below the neutral line. The frontline gauges took a breather, after showcasing a scintillating performance in last five trading sessions. However, investors got some comfort after Finance Minister Arun Jaitley promised more structural and market-oriented reforms as well as stepping up infrastructure spending to accelerate economic growth beyond the current 7.6 per cent. He also promised to reform the tax structure to make it simpler, predictable and stable. For today's trade Nifty likely to trade in the range between 8195 – 8215 in the upper side and 8145 – 8125 in the lower side.

 - Bonds fall on Fed Outlook as U.S Stocks Fluctuate; Crude Climbs: -Bonds fell as the Federal Reserve seems intent to raise interest rates this summer amid signs inflation is picking up, while oil headed for its longest run of monthly gains in five years and stocks in the U.S. were little changed.
 - China Stock-Index Futures Tumble 10% before Sharp Rebound: Chart: -Another swing has rattled Chinese traders, with CSI 300 futures tumbling by the daily limit before bouncing back. The drop comes two weeks after the Hang Seng China Enterprises Index futures briefly plunged in heavy volume without explanation. The volatility had little impact on the underlying CSI 300, which rose 2.6 percent at the midday break.
 - Dollar holds steady after positive U.S. data, more reports ahead: The dollar held steady at two-month highs against the other major currencies on Tuesday, after the release of positive U.S. data and investors were still eyeing the release of reports on manufacturing activity in the Chicago area and U.S. consumer confidence.
 - U.S. natural gas futures jump 4% as forecasts turn warmer: U.S. natural gas futures rallied sharply on Tuesday, as forecasts for the coming week turned warmer, boosting near-term demand expectations for the heating fuel. Forecasts originally called for mild summer weather during the period. Natural gas prices have closely tracked weather forecasts in recent weeks, as traders try to gauge the impact of shifting outlooks on early summer cooling demand.
