MARKET COMMENTARY

A session after displaying a distressing performance, Indian benchmark indices managed a modestly positive close on Friday, as investors accumulated quality stocks at attractive levels. Sentiments got a boost after India's current account deficit (CAD) declined sharply to \$0.3 billion (0.1% of Gross Domestic Product) in the fourth quarter of ended March 2016 (FY16) from \$ 7.1 billion (1.3%), in third quarter ended December 2015, on account of lower trade gap. Besides, firm global cues coupled with the appreciation in rupee value against the dollar added to the optimistic sentiments. For today's trade Nifty likely to trade in the range between 8185 – 8205 in the upper side and 8165 - 8145 in the lower side.



 - Stocks Climb with Pound as Brexit Campaign Suspended; Oil Gains: -Global stocks rebounded from a fourweek low and commodities advanced with the pound as campaigning in Britain's referendum on European Union membership was suspended for a second day. German bonds fell as demand for haven assets cooled.
 - Dollar drops to 1-week lows vs. other majors: The dollar dropped to one-week lows against the other major currencies on Friday, after the release of mixed U.S. economic reports did little to boost optimism over the strength of the economy and the Federal Reserve's decision to hold interest rates continued to weigh.
 - Crude oil prices rise for first time in seven days: - Crude oil prices rose on Friday for the first time in seven days due to Dollar drops to 1-week lows vs. other majors, but are set to end the week lower as trading remains volatile before Britain's June 23 referendum on its EU membership.
 - ➢ Gold Slides from near Two-Year High as Brexit Bets Retreat: Gold fell from the highest in almost two years as traders pared bets on the outcome of next week's U.K. vote on membership in the European Union, reducing demand for the metal as a haven. The pound erased losses against the dollar after the killing of a U.K. lawmaker Thursday fueled speculation the nation's voters will be more likely to favor remaining in the European Union in next week's referendum. Gold has advanced this month as those pushing to leave the EU held a steady lead in opinion polls.
