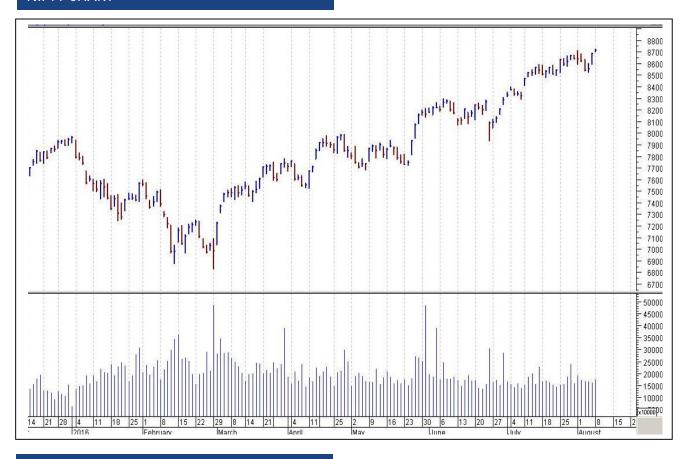

MARKET COMMENTARY

Indian equity markets that traded on a firm note in early deals taking cues from global markets, traded in green throughout the day, with benchmark indices BSE Sensex and NSE Nifty closing around their 52-week high. The Sensex hits its highest level since August 01, 2016, while Nifty hits its highest level since April 16, 2015. The sentiments got boosted after Finance Minister Arun Jaitley said that Indian economy has defied global slowdown and geo-political tensions and is now poised to seize the opportunity to grow faster. Investors' morale remained upbeat after Moody's Investors Service stated that Indian government's targeting of inflation at four percent with a range of plus/minus two percent is a credit positive measure that will help macroeconomic stability. For today's trade Nifty likely to trade in the range between 8725 – 8745 in the upper side and 8685 – 8665 in the lower side.

 - Stocks Climb to Year High as Commodities Advance on U.S. Outlook: - Stocks rose to a one-year high, led by energy shares, and commodities gained on speculation the U.S. economy is strong enough to sustain growth while only triggering a gradual increase in interest rates.
 - ➤ U.S. natural gas futures slide 2% to more than 1-week low: - U.S. natural gas futures fell sharply on Monday, touching a more than one-week low as forecasts for less hot weather in the days ahead dampened demand expectations for the cooling fuel.
 - Oil spikes 2% on fresh push for OPEC supply freeze: - Oil prices added to strong overnight gains in North American trade on Monday, as sentiment was boosted amid renewed hopes for an agreement among exporters to freeze output. According to people familiar with the matter, several OPEC members, including Venezuela, Ecuador and Kuwait, are now pushing for fresh talks on setting new limits for oil production this fall in an effort to stabilize the market. Qatar's Energy Minister Mohammed Bin Saleh al-Sada, who is serving as OPEC president this year, said in a statement on Monday the cartel will hold on an informal meeting in Algeria on September 26-28.
 - ➢ Gold struggles near 1-week lows on Fed rate hike outlook: - Gold prices struggled in North American trade on Monday, touching a one-week low after the latest <u>U.S. employment report</u> bolstered expectations of faster economic growth and revived speculation that the Federal Reserve will raise interest rates this year.
