Buying activity which remained buoyant throughout the session, as investors continued piling up hefty positions almost across the counters and as rate hike jitters faded. Indian equity benchmarks made a gapup opening after Reserve Bank of India in its latest report stated that the near-term growth outlook for India seems brighter than last fiscal and the economy is likely to expand at 7.6 percent in 2016-17. For today's trade Nifty likely to trade in the range between 8765 – 8785 in the upper side and 8735 – 8715 in the lower side.

 - Dollar Advances as Treasuries Decline on Interest-Rate Outlook: - The dollar strengthened and Treasuries fell as Federal Reserve Vice Chairman Stanley Fischer said the world's largest economy was close to full employment, reinforcing speculation that policy makers are moving toward raising borrowing costs.
 - Dollar index near 3-week highs after strong U.S. data: - The dollar hit fresh two-week highs against the other major currencies on Tuesday, after comments by Federal Reserve Vice Chairman Stanley Fischer added to expectations for an upcoming U.S. rate hike.
 - ➤ U.S. natural gas touches fresh 8-week high on tropical storm activity: U.S. natural gas futures rose to a new eight-week high on Tuesday, as traders continued to eye potential storm activity in the Gulf of Mexico. According to the U.S. Bureau of Safety and Environmental Enforcement, gas operators in the U.S. Gulf of Mexico have shut production equal to about 190 million cubic feet per day of natural gas as a precaution against a tropical storm, it said on Monday.
 - Gold languishes at 5-week lows as traders wait for Fed rate clues: Gold prices were under pressure during North American hours on Tuesday, struggled near five-week lows as investors focused on the next set of U.S. data to see whether it supports expectations that the Federal Reserve will raise interest rates soon. In an interview with Bloomberg TV earlier in the day, Fed Vice Chairman Stanley Fischer said the U.S. job market is nearly at full strength and the pace of interest rate increases by the U.S. central bank will depend on how well the economy is doing.
