MARKET COMMENTARY

The Indian equity markets witnessed a lack-luster and volatile day of trade on Monday after showing firm trend in Friday's session. Uncertainty over monetary policies has helped reignite volatility in global markets as well as the local markets, with traders split over what action the BOJ will undertake in its review Wednesday, while bets on an interest-rate hike from the Fed this week remain somewhat strong as inflation data for August rose more than projected. Back home, investor got some comfort with DIPP Secretary Ramesh Abhishek's statement that implementation of the goods and services tax (GST) is bound to be a game changer for India's manufacturing sector and will enhance ease of doing business in the country, some support also came with report that Finance Ministry officials are expected to pitch a ratings upgrade to Moody's by stressing upon the various reform initiatives taken by the Narendra Modi government, including the GST, bankruptcy code, and inflation targeting through the monetary policy committee, among others. For today's trade Nifty likely to trade in the range between 8835 – 8845 in the upper side and 8885 – 8865 in the lower side.

 - Stocks Climb as Dollar Falls on Waning Fed Wagers; Crude Rallies: -Stocks rose around the world, buoyed by gains in commodities prices, and the dollar weakened on speculation the Federal Reserve will hold interest rates steady this week.
 - Dollar extends losses with eyes on central banks: - The dollar extended losses against the other major currencies on Monday, as investors became more cautious ahead of the Federal Reserve and the Bank of Japan's highlyanticipated policy meetings this week.
 - Oil rises on hopes for output freeze deal but glut concerns remain: - Oil prices ticked higher during North American hours on Monday, after Venezuelan President Nicolas Maduro said over the weekend that OPEC and non-OPEC countries were "close" to reaching a deal to stabilize oil markets and that he aimed for a deal to be announced this month.
 - ▶ U.S. natural gas edges lower but remains near 3-month highs:- U.S. natural gas futures declined on Monday, but held near the highest level in almost three-months amid forecasts for warmer than normal temperatures across most parts of the continental U.S. in the days ahead
 - Gold prices rise as dollar slips ahead of Fed meeting: Gold prices held on to overnight gains during North America's session on Monday, as the U.S. dollar slipped amid expectations of no rate change from the Federal Reserve this week. Markets are currently pricing in just a 15% chance of a rate hike this week, according to Investing.com's Fed Rate Monitor Tool. For December, odds stood at around 54%.


