MARKET COMMENTARY

Indian benchmarks witnessed yet another volatile day of trade ahead of the September F&O expiry scheduled on Thursday. The optimism in domestic markets petered out completely by the end of trade and the benchmarks even drifted in to the negative territory to complete a hat-trick of negative close despite getting off to a positive opening. Sentiments remained subdued with WTO estimates showing that world trade will grow more slowly than expected in 2016, expanding by just 1.7%, well below the April forecast of 2.8%. For today's trade Nifty likely to trade in the range between 8725 – 8745 in the upper side and 8685 – 8665 in the lower side.

 - Stocks Rise After Debate as Consumer Confidence Jumps; Oil Falls: - Stocks rose as data showed American consumer confidence rose to the highest since 2007 and speculation grew that presidential nominee Hillary Clinton beat Donald Trump in their first debate. Mexico's peso rallied. Oil sank.
 - Dollar slightly higher, yen underperforms after first debate: -The dollar pushed higher against most of the other major currencies on Tuesday and the yen underperformed as investors digested the first U.S. presidential debate, amid the view that Hillary Clinton came out best.
 - Oil slides 3% after Saudis, Iran crush hopes of OPEC supply deal: Oil prices plunged nearly 3% during North American hours on Tuesday, extending overnight losses, after both Saudi Arabia and Iran played down expectations for a deal to freeze or cut oil production at the closely watched informal OPEC meeting on Wednesday. Oil ministers from both countries said on Tuesday that talks among OPEC and non-OPEC oil producers in Algiers are "consultative," casting doubt on the chances of any policy decision during the meeting.
 - Gold slumps in wake of U.S. presidential debate: - Gold prices were lower during North America's session on Tuesday, extending overnight losses as markets declared Democrat Hillary Clinton as the winner of her first U.S. presidential debate with Republican Donald Trump.
 - ➤ U.S. CB consumer confidence unexpectedly hits 9-year high in September: U.S. consumer confidence unexpectedly jumped in September to more than a nine-year high, bolstering optimism over the health the U.S.
