MARKET COMMENTARY

Indian equity benchmarks traded in red in tight range for most part of the day in absence of any upside triggers. The selling pressure was visible across IT, TECK and Oil & Gas sector which pulled market lower to end in red for third straight session. The benchmarks made a cautious start and were trading slightly in red in early deals on account of selling in frontline blue chip counters tracking rise in crude oil prices in overnight trade. The sentiments were under pressure after Indian rupee fell against the US dollar on account of buying of American currency by banks and importers. For today's trade Nifty likely to trade in the range between 8725 – 8745 in the upper side and 8665 – 8645 in the lower side.

 - Stocks Decline as Bonds Little Changed after U.S. Jobs Report: -Stocks fell while Treasuries and the dollar were little changed after data showing steady growth in the U.S. jobs market kept the Federal Reserve on track to raise interest rates by the end of the year.
 - Dollar index turns lower after U.S. nonfarm payrolls: - The dollar turned lower against the other major currencies on Friday, pulling away from a two-month peak after U.S. employment data for September disappointed analysts' expectations. The U.S. Labor Department said the economy added 156,000 jobs in September, compared to expectations for 175,000. The economy created 167,000 jobs in August, whose figure was revised from a previously estimated 151,000. The report also showed that the unemployment rate ticked up to 5.0% last month from 4.9% in August. Analysts had expected an unchanged reading for September. Average hourly earnings rose 0.2% in September, in line with expectations and after an uptick of 0.1% the previous month.
 - OPEC officials set for flurry of meetings to nail down Algeria deal: -OPEC officials are embarking on an unusual flurry of meetings in the next six weeks, OPEC sources said on Friday, to nail down details of their deal to cut production agreed last week in Algiers.
 - Oil edges lower; U.S. crude holds above \$50 on output cut hopes: -OPEC members are scheduled to meet November 30 in Vienna to discuss the details of an agreement to cut output to 32.5-33 million barrels per day.
