### **MARKET COMMENTARY**

The sell-off continued on Monday as equity benchmarks lost over half a percent, in addition to 1.3 percent loss in last week as investors remained cautious ahead of September quarter earnings. Weakness across the globe and fall in index heavyweights drove the market down. The 30-share BSE Sensex was down 143.63 points at 27529.97 and the 50-share NSE Nifty fell 63 points to 8520.40. The broader markets also caught in bear grip as the BSE Midcap falling nearly a percent on weak breadth. About 1513 shares declined against 1298 advancing shares on the exchange.

For today's trade Nifty likely to trade in the range between 8550 – 8590 in the upper side and 8500 – 8450 in the lower side

  - Treasuries Rise as Dollar Falls amid Economic Data; Oil Slumps: -Treasuries rebounded from a four-month low and the dollar fell after mixed economic data in the world's largest economy bolstered the case for accommodative monetary policy. Oil retreated.
  - ➢ Dollar still on the downside after U.S. economic reports: The dollar remained lower against the other major currencies on Monday, after the release of downbeat economic reports from the U.S. dampened optimism over the strength of the economy, although the greenback still remained within close distance of a seven-month peak. The Federal Reserve of New York said its <a href="Empire State">Empire State</a> manufacturing index fell to -6.80 in October from -1.99 the previous month. Analysts had expected the index to rise to 1.00 this month.
  - ➢ Oil prices slip on rise in U.S. drilling, strong dollar: Oil prices edged lower on Monday, pulled down by a rising rig count in the United States and a strong dollar but expectations of an OPEC intervention next month to curb production gave them a floor. Traders said that WTI was under pressure from a report on Friday by oil services provider Baker Hughes showed U.S. drillers added four rigs in the week to Oct. 14. It was the 16th week in a row that oil drillers had gone without making cuts, indicating more production to come.
  - Gold prices little changed near 4month lows: - Gold prices were little changed near four-month lows on Monday, as a broadly stronger U.S. dollar continued to dampen demand for the precious metal.
