MARKET COMMENTARY

Indian stock markets finished the session on a dull note, modestly below the neutral line as investors at large remained reluctant to build on long positions amid weak global cues, as oil prices dipped and after Chicago Fed President Charles Evans said that the Fed could raise short-term interest rates by three quarter-point by the end of 2017. The session largely remained characterized by choppiness as the aimless indices moved only slowly creeping towards the previous closing levels after the early decline. For today's trade Nifty likely to trade in the range between 8725 – 8755 in the upper side and 8665 – 8645 in the lower side.

 - Stocks Struggle for Direction amid Mixed Earnings; Metals Rally: - U.S. stocks fluctuated near a two-week high as traders assessed a batch of mixed earnings from blue-chip companies while weighing the outlook for interest rates in the world's largest economy. Metals climbed.
 - ➤ Dollar steady at 9-month highs, sterling lower: The dollar was trading at nine-month highs against the other major currencies on Tuesday amid expectations for higher U.S. interest rates, while the pound slid ahead of remarks by Bank of England Governor Mark Carney later in the day. The index has rallied 3.44% so far this month as hawkish remarks by Federal Reserve officials in recent weeks solidified expectations for a rate hike before the year's end.
 - U.S. natural gas sinks 5% on unseasonably warm weather outlook:

 U.S. natural gas futures plunged to the lowest level in almost seven weeks on Tuesday, as forecasts showing unseasonably warm temperatures across the U.S. Midwest in the days ahead dampened demand expectations for the heating fuel.
 - Oil turns lower as focus shifts to U.S. stockpile data: Oil prices were under pressure in North American trade on Tuesday, reversing earlier gains as fading expectations of a coordinated production cut among major global oil producers and a stronger U.S. dollar weighed.
 - Gold rises despite strong dollar, Fed rate hike outlook: - Gold prices added to overnight gains during North America's session on Tuesday, as market players looked ahead to more U.S. economic data for clues on the likelihood of a December
