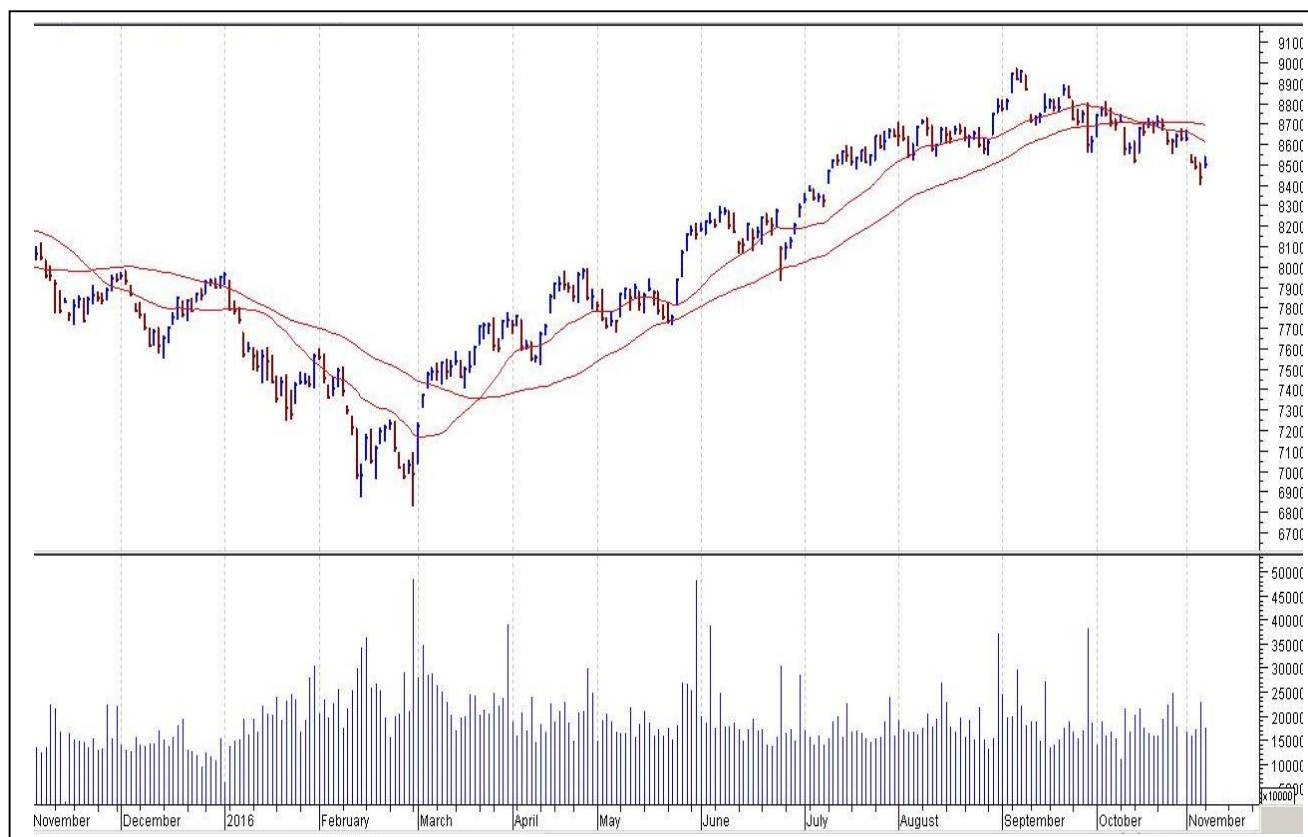

MARKET COMMENTARY

Thursday turned out to be a fabulous day of trade for Indian equity markets, where frontline gauges garnered a gain of over half a percent, recapturing their crucial 27,400 (Sensex) and 8,450 (Nifty) levels, as Hillary Clinton's chances of winning the US presidential elections improved. After making a gap-up opening, domestic bourses traded in tight band for most part of the day's trade, as market participants took encouragement with a survey that India improved its ranking by one spot in a global index of business optimism, with policy reforms and Goods and Services tax (GST) expected to become a reality soon. For today's trade Nifty likely to trade in the range between 8515 – 8535 in the upper side and 8485 – 8465 in the lower side.

- Stocks Rise, Treasuries Fall with Gold as Clinton Gets FBI Boost: - Global stocks rallied with commodities and Mexico's peso on speculation Hillary Clinton's chances of a U.S. election win increased after the FBI said her handling of e-mails wasn't a crime. Demand for havens waned, with higher-rated bonds, the yen and gold retreating.
- Dollar holds onto gains as markets eye U.S. election results: - The dollar held onto gains against the other major's currencies on Monday, as fresh hopes that Hillary Clinton could win the upcoming presidential election boosted demand for the greenback.
- Gold tumbles more than 1% after FBI says no charges for Clinton: - Gold prices were sharply lower during North American hours on Monday, as demand for safe-haven assets ebbed after the FBI said [no new evidence was found to warrant charges against Hillary Clinton](#) in the investigation of her emails just two days before the U.S. election.
- Oil futures rise but remain within sight of multi-month lows: - Oil prices pushed higher during North American hours on Monday, as appetite for riskier assets improved after the FBI said [no new evidence was found to warrant charges against Hillary Clinton](#) in the investigation of her emails just two days before the U.S. election.
- U.S. natural gas rebounds after sharp falls last week: - U.S. natural gas futures pushed higher on Monday, bouncing back from sharp falls last week as market players looked ahead to cold weather forecast in key gas-consuming regions in the U.S. which should boost demand for the heating fuel.
