MARKET COMMENTARY

Wednesday's session turned out to be a daunting day of trade for Indian equity benchmarks where frontline gauges tumbled below their crucial 28,300 (Sensex) and 8,450 (Nifty) levels, though markets made some recovery in second half of trade but it was not enough to cover-up all the losses. Sentiments remained dampened, as Republican Donald Trump stunned the world by defeating heavily favored Hillary Clinton in the race for the White House, ending eight years of Democratic rule and sending the United States on a new, uncertain path. Traders also reacted negatively to the government's historic decision to withdraw Rs 500 and Rs 1,000 notes from circulation at midnight, saying this decision was taken to break the grip of corruption and black money. For today's trade Nifty likely to trade in the range between 8455 – 8465 in the upper side and 8425 – 8395 in the lower side.

 - ➤ U.S. Stocks Fluctuate as Investors Weigh Impact from Trump Win: - U.S. stocks fluctuated in volatile trading in the aftermath of Donald Trump's surprise presidential election win, as speculation the Republican will pursue businessfriendly policies offset some of the broader uncertainty surrounding his ascent.
 - Dollar turns higher as markets digest Trump win: - The dollar turned higher against the other major's currencies on Wednesday, as the greenback continued to recover from sharp losses posted following news Donald Trump had been elected President of the United States.
 - Trump win stokes fears over climate change goals, hits renewable stocks:
 Donald Trump's election as U.S. president triggered fears that his view that global warming is a hoax might lead other nations to scale back ambitions under a landmark climate change deal, while renewable energy stocks fell on world markets.
 - Gold also rose as Trump's win promises to reshape the relationship of the U.S. with the world, and the potential for unpredictability in American policy fuels speculation that the Federal Reserve will delay raising interest rates.
 - Copper for three-month delivery touched a 15-month high before trading up 2.9 percent at \$5,355 a metric ton, leading gainers as of 11:41 a.m. on the London Metal Exchange. Mining stocks benefited. Antofagasta Plc jumped 4.2 percent and Glencore Plc 2.8 percent.
