

### MARKET COMMENTARY

Indian benchmarks started the new month on a disturbing note as the benchmark equity indices failed to extend the four session northbound journey and settled with moderate cuts of over a quarter percent. It largely turned out to be a range bound session marred with high volatility as investors indulged in stock specific activities after country's economy grew lower than expected in the September quarter at 7.3%, as compared to 7.6% registered during the same period last fiscal year. The data indicate that the economy may witness the heavy impact of demonetisation in the third quarter and even some part of the fourth quarter. For today's trade Nifty likely to trade in the range between 8225 – 8235 in the upper side and 8185 – 8165 in the lower side.

  - Treasuries Drop before Jobs Data as Oil Gains; Dollar Declines: - Financial markets started the month on an uncertain footing after a dramatic November, with Treasuries extending losses, the dollar retreating against most of its peers and European stocks snapping a two-day advance.
  - Dollar index trims losses after upbeat ISM report: - The dollar trimmed losses against the other majors currencies on Thursday, after the release of upbeat U.S. manufacturing activity data offset more disappointing U.S. jobless claims report.
  - Oil prices extend rally on OPEC deal: Oil prices rose strongly on Thursday, building on the previous session's large gains after the Organization of the Petroleum Exporting Countries reached an agreement to cut production. OPEC agreed on its first production cut since 2008 on Wednesday, aimed at reducing a global supply overhang that has seen prices more than halve since mid-2014. The 14-member cartel is responsible for a third of global oil production, or 33.6 million barrels per day. The deal will see output cut by 1.2 million bpd from January 2017.
  - Gold eases from 10-month lows, but outlook remains dim: - Gold prices retraced some losses on Thursday after falling to almost 10-month lows as the dollar eased, but the precious metal remained under pressure amid expectations for higher U.S. interest rates.
  - ➤ U.S. natural gas futures for January rose to highest for front-month contract since December 2014 as cold weather seen sweeping west.
