MARKET COMMENTARY

Monday's session turned out to be a daunting day of trade for Indian equity benchmarks where frontline gauges tumbled below their crucial 26,600 (Sensex) and 8,200 (Nifty) levels. After a gap down opening, market never looked confident throughout the session and ended near the intraday low levels, as sentiments remained dampened with Industrial production shrinking an annual 1.9% in October, worsening from a 0.7% rise in the previous month and 9.8 per cent growth in the year-ago month. Industrial production has contracted in four out of seven months so far this fiscal. In the April-October period, production declined 0.3 per cent compared with 4.8 per cent growth last year. For today's trade Nifty likely to trade in the range between 8185 – 8195 in the upper side and 8165 – 8155 in the lower side.

- Crude oil range->\$49 to \$59.
 - Oil Soars as Output Deal Weighs on Bonds; U.S. Shares Mixed: - Crude oil surged to the highest in 17 months amid efforts to cut production, pushing up the outlook for global inflation and briefly sending 10-year Treasury yields above 2.5 percent for the first time since October 2014. U.S. stocks were mixed two days before a rate decision.
 - Dollar slips as focus turns to Federal Reserve: -The dollar slipped lower against the other major currencies on Monday, as investors turned their attention to the upcoming Federal Reserve meeting this week amid expectations that the central bank is on track to raise interest rates.
 - Gold falls to more than 10-month low on Fed rate hike view: - Gold prices fell to the lowest level in more than ten months on Monday, as expectations for a rate hike by the Federal Reserve this week continued to weigh on the precious metal.
 - Oil hits highest since mid-2015 as global producers agree to cut: - Oil rose by as much as 6.5 percent on Monday to an 18-month high after OPEC and some of its rivals reached their first deal since 2001 to jointly reduce output to try to tackle global oversupply and boost prices. The price is 50 percent higher than at this time last year, marking the largest year-on-year rise on any given day since September 2011. "OPEC have taken a very important step towards stopping the relentless build up in global stock levels and speeding up the rebalancing process, as long as compliance is strong, Libya and Nigeria fail to rebound and U.S. producers take time to respond," PVM Oil Associates strategist David Hufton said.
