MARKET COMMENTARY

Indian equity benchmarks traded jubilantly throughout the day and ended in green. Investors eyed President-elect Donald Trump's news conference scheduled later in the day for any clues to his policies on tax, fiscal spending, international trade and currencies. Being the world's largest economy, a firming growth in US could boost demand globally. Traders took support with Prime Minister Narendra Modi's statement that India is on threshold of becoming most digitized economy in the world. For today's trade Nifty likely to trade in the range between 8355 – 8375 in the upper side and 8365 – 8345 in the lower side.

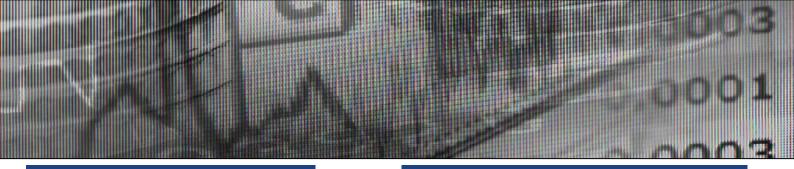

- Stocks, Bonds Mixed before Trump; Lira, Pound Drop: Markets Wrap: - U.S. stocks and Treasuries were little changed as investors awaited comments from Donald Trump for clues on the conviction behind his policy proclamations. Political risks weighed on Turkey's lira and the British pound.
 - Dollar extends gains as markets gear up for Trump conference: - The dollar extended gains against the other majors currencies on Wednesday, as investors were awaiting a highly-anticipated press conference by U.S. President-elect Donald Trump scheduled later in the day.
 - ▶ U.S. crude stocks up 4.097 mn barrels vs. forecast rise of 1.162 mn: U.S. crude stocks rose more than expected in the latest week, official data showed Wednesday. The EIA said crude inventories rose by 4.097 mn barrels after a drop of 7.051 mn barrels the previous week. Crude inventories were forecast to rise by 1.162 mn barrels. Gasoline stocks rose by 5.023 mn barrels after a hike of 8.307 mn the previous week. Gasoline inventories were expected to rise by 1.638 mn barrels. U.S. crude pared gains of over 1% and was up 0.47% at \$51.06 after data release.
 - ➤ U.S. natural gas extends bounce off 7-week low: U.S. natural gas futures were higher for the second day in a row on Wednesday, moving further away from a seven-week low as forecasts for the end of January turned colder, boosting demand for the heating fuel. Weather models initially predicted mild temperatures throughout most parts of the U.S. during the period.
