MARKET COMMENTARY

Equity benchmarks closed the session on a flat note amid consolidation Tuesday as investors awaited more corporate earnings and the outcome of Federal Reserve policy meeting due Wednesday.

The 30-share BSE Sensex opened with a gap up of more than 100 points after two-day profit booking and a long weekend but erased early gains to trade in a tight range for the rest of the session.

The Sensex closed up 2.78 points at 29,921.18 after hitting an intraday high of 30,069.24 and low of 29,804.12 while the 50-share NSE Nifty rose 9.75 points to 9,313.80. For todays trade nifty will trade in the range between 9280-9370.

 - ▶ U.S. Stocks Fluctuate Near Records, Oil Retreats: Markets Wrap: - U.S. stocks churned near record highs as earnings bolstered optimism in the economy before a raft of events that will set the tone on markets in the coming week. The yen fell to a six-week low versus the dollar.
 - West Texas Intermediate crude fell 0.3 percent to \$48.71. Oil fell 1 percent Monday as Libyan output surged, more rigs were added in the U.S. and Saudi Arabia cut prices to Asian customers.
 - Copper on the London Metals Exchange rose 0.9 percent. Gold declined 0.3 percent to \$1,252.84 an ounce, after dropping 0.9 percent on Monday.
 - Dollar index holds steady with eyes on Fed meeting: - The dollar held steady against other major currencies on Tuesday, as investors remained cautious ahead of the Federal Reserve's policy decision due on Wednesday. The dollar came under pressure after the Institute of Supply Management said on Monday that its manufacturing purchasing managers' index fell to 54.8 in April from 57.2 the previous month, compared to expectations for a downtick to 56.5. However, U.S. Treasury Secretary Steven Mnuchin said on Monday that economic growth of 3% is achievable in the next two years as the Trump administration is planning to dramatically cut taxes. Market participants were also eyeing the Federal Reserve's two-day policy meeting this week. While the central bank is widely expected to hold interest rates, investors were eyeing hints on the pace of future rata hikac


