Erasing a huge chunk of its gains through the day, the market ended the session on a flat note, with the indices ending above key milestones of 30K and 9400.

The Sensex closed up 2.81 points at 30250.98, while the Nifty ended higher by 15.10 points at 9422.40. The market breadth favoured the declines as 1,246 shares advanced against a fall of 1,588 shares, while 169 shares were unchanged.

 - ➤ U.S. Stocks Drop Most in 3 Weeks, Treasuries Rise: Markets Wrap: - U.S. stocks fell the most in almost a month as tepid earnings raised new doubts about the strength of the American consumer, causing a spike in equity volatility. Treasuries rose with gold on haven demand, while oil added to gains.
 - Dollar trims gains, holds steady vs. rivals: -The dollar trimmed gains and held steady against other major currencies on Thursday, after the release of upbeat U.S. economic reports, although expectations for June rate hike continued to support.
 - > OPEC sees more oil supply outside the group, countering its cuts: - OPEC on Thursday sharply raised its forecast for oil supply from non-member countries in 2017 as higher prices encourage U.S. shale drillers to pump more, hampering the producer group's efforts to clear a glut and support prices by cutting output. In a monthly report, the Organization of the Petroleum Exporting Countries said outside producers would boost supply by 950,000 barrels per day (bpd) this year, up from 580,000 bpd expected previously. 聽As a result, OPEC cut the forecast 2017 demand for its crude by 300,000 bpd.
 - ▶ U.S. natural gas jumps to 15-week high after weekly storage data: - U.S. natural gas futures added to gains on Thursday, rising to the strongest level in around 15 weeks after data showed that natural gas supplies in storage in the U.S. rose less than expected last week.

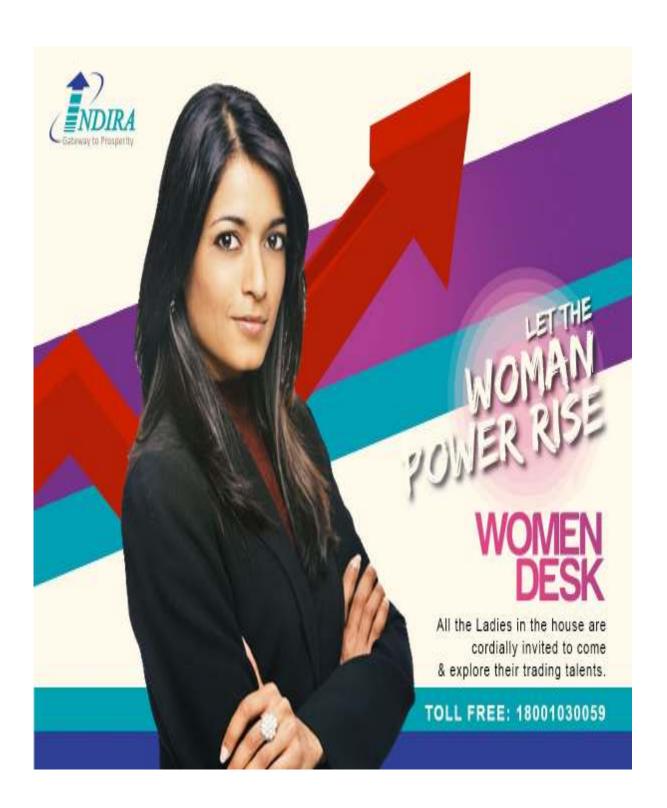
