MARKET COMMENTARY

Equity benchmarks recouped previous session's losses on Monday, ending at fresh record closing high as investors cheered better macro data that raised hopes for a rate cut. Even a likely early start to the monsoon also lifted sentiment.

The 30-share BSE Sensex was up 133.97 points at 30,322.12 and the 50-share NSE Nifty rose 44.50 points to 9,445.40, backed by banks, FMCG, metals and pharma stocks.

 - Oil Rally Lifts Stocks as Dollar Slips with Bonds: Markets Wrap: - Crude rallied on the prospect a deal to <u>cut global supply</u> will be extended, leading a broader advance across commodities and spurring the currencies of major exporters. U.S. stocks advanced, while the dollar retreated.
 - ➤ Dollar index edges lower, yen eases: The dollar edged lower Monday as the yen gave up gains after safe-haven buying. The yen was off 0.20% at 113.61 after earlier gains on renewed concerns about North Korea's nuclear program. Weak U.S. data Friday dampened the outlook for the pace of further U.S. tightening this year.
 - ➤ U.S. natural gas futures on track to snap 4-day win streak: U.S. natural gas futures fell sharply on Monday, on track to snap a foursession win streak, as traders monitored shifting weather forecasts to assess the outlook for spring demand and supply levels.
 - Gold rises to one-week high on weaker dollar, North Korea jitters: - Gold prices were higher in North American trade on Monday, trying for its fourth-straight winning session as a weaker U.S. dollar and another missile test by North Korea underpinned demand for the yellow metal.
 - Oil surges on Saudi/Russian backing for output cut extension: Oil jumped by over 3% Monday as Saudi Arabia and Russia agreed on the need to rein in output for another nine months.
 Brent crude added \$1.57, or 3.09%, to \$52.41.
 Saudi energy minister Khalid al-Falih and his Russian counterpart Alexander Novak issued a statement saying the output cut deal should be extended to March of next year.

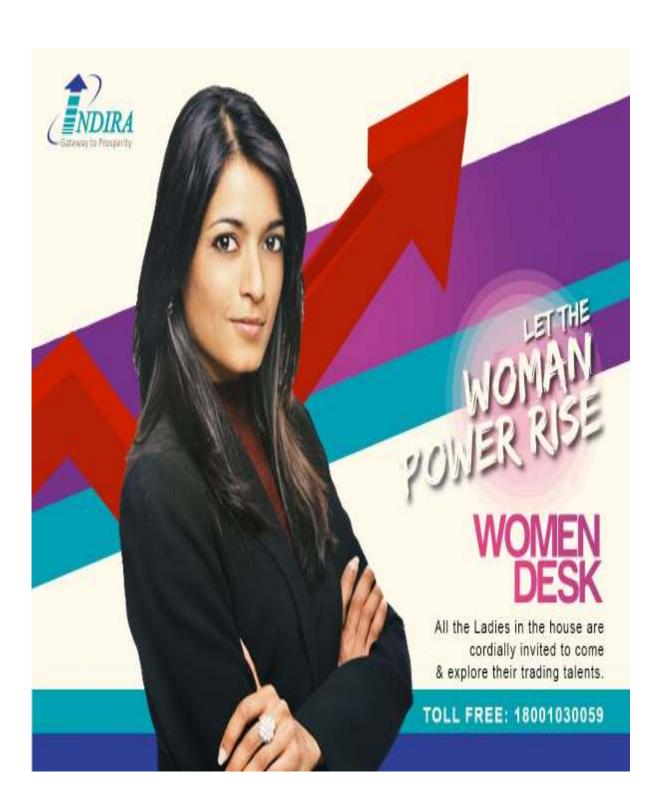
