

Treasuries fell with the dollar a markets shrugged off the latest terror attacks in the U.K. Crude slumped.
  - ➤ Dollar pares gains after U.S. service data misses forecasts: The dollar trimmed gains against a basket of the other major currencies on Monday, after reports showing that activity in the U.S. service sector slowed more than expected last month and U.S. factory orders fell for the first time in five months.
  - Sold trades at highest since mid-April as busy week kicks off: Gold prices rose to their highest level since mid-April in North American trade on Monday, as market players looked ahead to potentially market-moving events later in the week. 聽Europe is likely to set the tone for global financial markets this week, with the European Central Bank policy meeting and British general election on investors' minds.

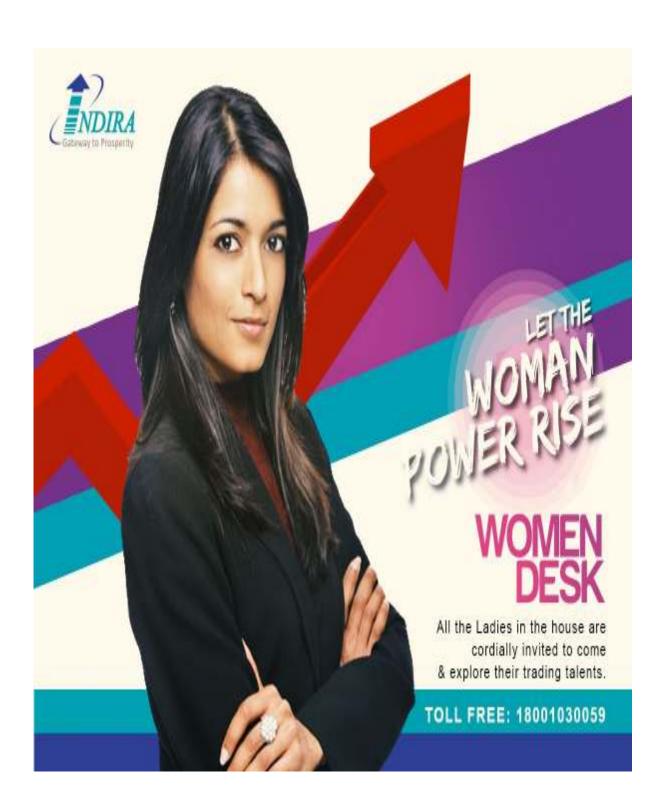
