

MARKET COMMENTARY

Equity benchmarks failed to hold its record high levels on Tuesday as investors preferred to book profits ahead of the outcome of monetary policy committee meeting due Wednesday. The Nifty ended below 9,650 level after hitting psychological 9,700-mark for the first time in opening trade.

The 30-share BSE Sensex was down 118.93 points at 31,190.56 and the 50-share NSE Nifty dropped 37.95 points to 9,637.15 following weakness in global peers.

For today trade nifty likely to trade in the range of 9580-9720.

 Treasuries Advance: Markets Wrap: Caution reigned in a week loaded with
 events that could change the tone on
 financial markets, from the ECB's policy
 meeting to Britain's increasingly uncertain
 election. U.S. stocks retreated, while
 havens including gold, the yen and
 Treasuries gained.
 - ▶ Dollar down 1% against yen as risk events loom: -The dollar fell below the 110 level against the yen on Tuesday, hitting a one-and-a-half-month low as investor jitters over looming geopolitical risk events sparked a flight to safe haven assets. The dollar came under pressure ahead of former FBI Director James Comey's testimony to a Senate committee on Thursday. Investors are fearful that the Trump administration may be further damaged by any revelations that could emerge when Comey testifies about Russia's alleged involvement in the U.S. election.
 - Port bans choke Qatar's commodity trade as gas supply worries grow: A campaign by leading Arab powers to isolate Qatar is disrupting trade in commodities from crude oil to metals and food, and deepening fears of a possible jolt to the global gas market, where the tiny Gulf state is a major player.
 - U.S. natural gas futures rise for 1st time in 7 sessions: - U.S. natural gas futures were higher on Tuesday, rising for the first time in seven sessions as investors returned to the market to seek cheap valuations in wake of recent losses.


