 - Central Banks Roil Currencies, U.S. Stocks Rise: Markets Wrap:- Central banks continued to set the tone on global currency markets Wednesday, with the latest comments from the Bank of England sparking a risk-on tone that lifted assets from the pound to U.S. stocks.
 - Dollar extends losses as U.S. pending home sales fall:- The dollar extended losses Wednesday as pending home sales in May unexpectedly fell. Analysts had expected sales in May to rise 0.8% from the previous month. The dollar index's fall came as the euro hit one-year highs. The euro subsequently retreated after a report that upbeat remarks Tuesday by European Central Bank President Mario Draghi on the euro-zone recovery had been misinterpreted.
 - Gold futures rise as dollar, stocks wobble on U.S. healthcare delay:-Gold prices edged higher in North American trade on Wednesday, as the U.S. dollar and global stock markets wobbled, drawing investor attention to the precious metal.
 - Oil prices higher after supply data shows drop in gas stockpiles:- Oil prices were higher in North American trade on Wednesday, after data from the U.S. Energy Information Administration showed that domestic crude supplies rose last week, but gasoline inventories fell more than forecast.
 - U.S. gas futures break out to 4-week high on bullish demand outlook:-U.S. natural gas futures rose to a fourweek high on Wednesday..

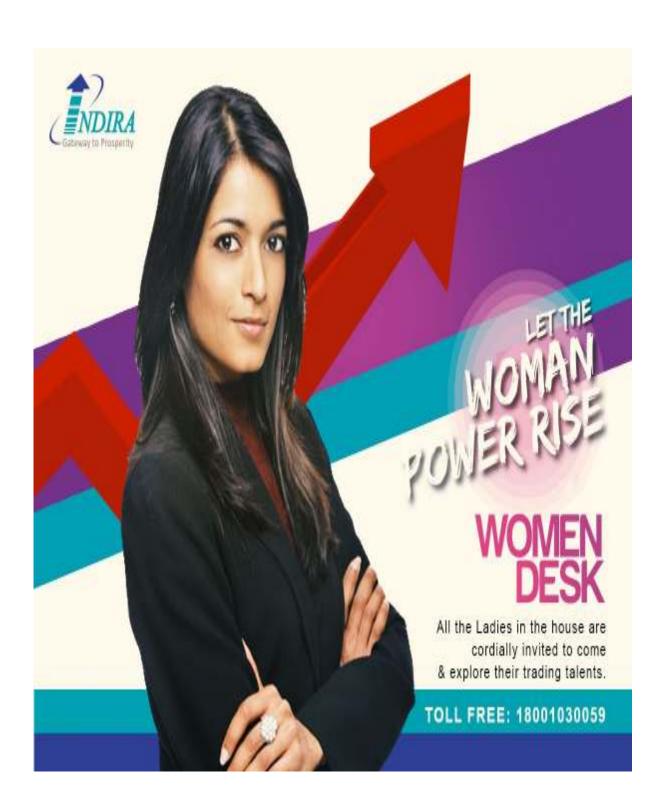
